BUS RULES & BEHAVIOR

Please discuss proper bus behavior with your child. The bus rules and consequences are found in the Student Handbook in the front of the agenda.

Riding the bus is a privilege. When students misbehave on the bus and do not follow the rules, safety is an issue. Drivers cannot have their full attention on the road if they have to constantly address students for discipline issues. Students who have continuous misbehaviors will be in danger of being suspended from the school bus.

Our students can earn "Ready to Ride" bus tickets from the drivers. These tickets allow for the children to be recognized for good behavior on the bus.

I am looking forward to a wonderful year of learning, growth, and fun with my shipmates as we set sail in the 2018-2019 school year.


<u>Introducing Mrs. Jessica Santana-4th Grade Teacher</u>
