Come have fun with your friends and show your Pirate spirit and class pride by painting on your own personal asphalt canvas! The proceeds will go into the Grad Night account!

- First, download the Parking Space form from the school's website or from your Class of 2023 Canvas page.
- Second, come to Pearl High School with your form, and purchase your parking decal with assigned parking space on Tuesday, July 26 or Wednesday, July 27 from 8:00 am-3:00 pm.
- Third, purchase your painting permit from Mrs. McHenry for \$50. You may pay by cash, check, or through Cash App \$phs2023. The \$50 includes a \$10 deposit that you will get back if you paint over your space at the end of the year.
- Last, sketch your design on the <u>back of this form</u>, take a picture of it, and email it to Mrs. McHenry (<u>smchenry@pearlk12.com</u>) for principal approval.
- Designs must be submitted to Mrs. McHenry no later than 3:30 p.m. on Friday, July 29.

Sketch Rules and Guidelines:

- 1. The senior will be required to secure design approval prior to applying artwork.
- 2. The design proposal must be approved by Dr. Brewer. Deviation from the approved design proposal will warrant surrender of the reserved space for the remainder of the term and forfeiture of the fee, meaning NO refunds.
- 3. We encourage seniors to express themselves through the artwork in their design. Inappropriate words, symbols, or pictures are prohibited. The reserved space number must remain as well (see sketch page).
- 4. Seniors will be required to use exterior latex paints applied with brush, roller, or sponge. No spray cans or sprayer devices will be permitted. It is important to note that seniors MAY NOT paint anywhere outside of the designated space. The design cannot come within 12 inches of the parking space line, and the space number must remain visible.
- 5. "Paint Your Space" days will be **Sunday July 31th through Thursday August 4th**. You will sign up for times and days after you pay to paint your spot. The senior MUST have an adult/parent with them while they paint the space, and the senior must have a copy of the approved design proposal available.
- 6. Again, failure to follow ANY of the above rules will automatically forfeit your painting privileges and paid fees.
- 7. Parking spaces will be painted over at the end of the year BY THE SENIOR no later than **May 11**. Failure to paint over the space results in forfeiture of deposit.

Reserving and painting parking spaces is a privilege rather than a right. This fundraising opportunity will benefit your SENIOR CLASS, so let's all paint a space! General parking spaces will still be available for seniors who do not wish to paint their space; however, a permit must still be purchased for any senior wishing to drive on campus.
