Mastery Grading & Retest Guidelines - All Content Areas

- a. shall implement the following guidelines related to formal assessments:
 - i. Assessments should be standards-based and measure students' level of mastery on specific learning objectives,
 - ii. Additional practice will be provided for students who do not achieve initial mastery (79%),
 - iii. Following additional practice, new opportunities shall be provided to measure student mastery. A maximum score of 79% can be earned.
- Only students earning a 78% or lower will be reassessed.
- Students will receive the **highest of the 2 scores** in the gradebook (test or retest scale).
- Scores will be determined based on the number of questions on the reassessment.
 - o 100% on retest = 80% gradebook
 - \circ Mastery on retest (79 99) = **79%** in gradebook (a C)
 - Partial Mastery on retest (60 78) = **69%** (a D)
 - Not Mastered on retest (59 and below) = 59% (F)

Memory Jogger Quiz Grading (3-5)

- 5/5 = 100% in gradebook
- 4/5 = 80% in gradebook
- 3/5 = 70% in gradebook
- 2/5 = 60% in gradebook
- 1/5 = 55% in gradebook
