Students will create a paper mache bowl using flour and water paste and newspaper. Students will demonstrate correct skills by following all directions. Students will decorate their bowls with supplies available at school or home.

2PR Demonstrate increased technical skill and craftsmanship by using more complex processes and materials to design and create two- and three-dimensional artworks.

Materials

- Newspaper
- White paper
- Mixing bowl and whisk
- Small bowl for a mold
- 1 cup of plain flour
- 1 cup of warm water
- Plus extra tap water
- A paintbrush
- Paint



Instructions for Paper Mache Paste

- Mix together 1 mug of sifted flour and 1 mug of warm water in a large bowl.
- 2. The paste should be smooth and batter-like with no lumps. If the mixture is too stiff, add a little tap water.
- 3. Add a pinch of salt to stop the paste from going mouldy.



Paper Mache Bowl Instructions

- 1.) grab yourself a small bowl plastic is best.
- *If you don't have a plastic one, you can use a metal or ceramic bowl, just slide a layer of plastic wrap over it first
- 2.) tear the newspaper into strips
- 3.) make up a mix of paper mache paste –
- 1:1 flour and water



Paper Mache Bowl Instructions

4.) dip the newspaper into the paste and layer over the bowl

you'll want a few layers – the more the better. About 5 layers

5.) leave to dry overnight

gently press out the bowl – if you have a plastic bowl, just give it a bit of a squeeze and it will pop out

paint and decorate – tissue paper, any kind of paint

Tip: You can use craft paper, pages from old books, or wrapping paper
