- Learning Objective: The learner will use drawn on colored paper to create a paper weaving, using warm and cool colors.

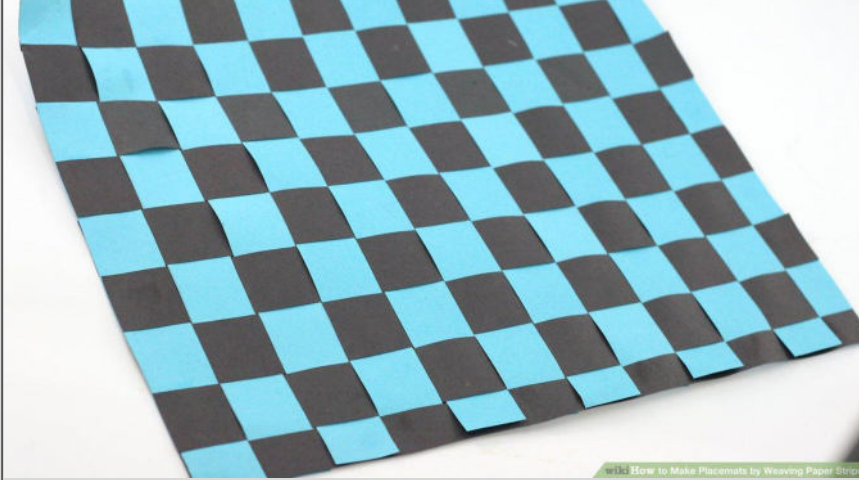
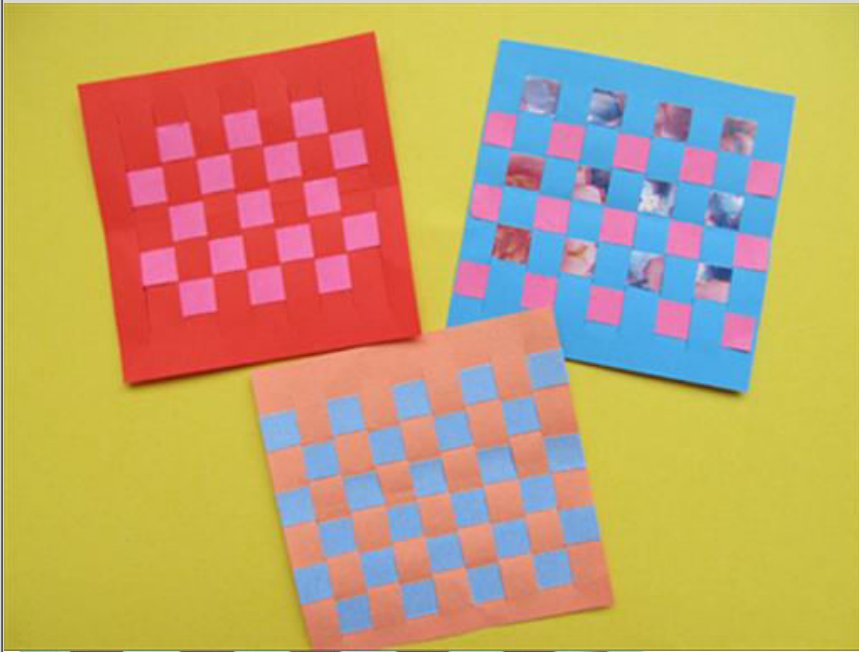

Project Details

- Materials needed: Pencil, Ruler, Scissors, Tape, and colored paper.
- Use two sheets of paper, notebook size or bigger. If possible use contrasting colors or warm and cold colors.
- Cut strips roughly half inch,
- Take your time and have the strips pushed tight.

Steps and Process

- Step 1: On two different color papers (Warm and Cool), you will create a random design on each paper.
- Step 2: Fold one paper in half and cut half inch strips. Will demonstrate when we are at the part of the lesson.
- Step 3: Cut second paper into half inch strips. Will demonstrate when we are at the part of the lesson.
- Step 4: Weave the two papers together. Will demonstrate when we are at the part of the lesson.
