PARAPROFESSIONALS WANTED!

Paraprofessionals are employed in school districts to deliver support to students and teachers in a classroom.

They are sometimes called teacher assistants, educational assistants, teacher aids or instructional assistants and are in great demand. With direction from a classroom teacher, a paraprofessional may work with children one-on-one or in a small group to reinforce learning in the classroom.

Duties vary depending upon the school, classroom and needs of individual children. Paraprofessionals typically work 30 hours a week, during the nine-month school year.

This can be a very rewarding start for those interested in a career as an elementary or special education teacher.
