NEW JERSEY'S STATEWIDE ASSESSMENT PROGRAM

- 2017 marks the 3rd administration of the Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers (PARCC).
- Students took PARCC English Language Arts and Literacy Assessments (ELA/L) in grades 3 – 11.
- Students took PARCC Mathematics Assessments in grades 3 8 and End of Course Assessments in Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II.

- Level 1: Not yet meeting grade-level expectations
- Level 2: Partially meeting grade-level expectations
- Level 3: Approaching grade-level expectations
- Level 4: Meeting grade-level expectations
