Prior Lake-Savage Area Schools has again been issued a clean audit report from independent audit firm of CliftonLarsonAllen, which is the highest opinion an auditor can issue for school districts.

Audits are done to ensure districts' compliance with state and federal requirements, internal and administrative controls and accuracy of financial and student data, documents, statements and reports used in the calculating of state and federal aid and grant payments.
