### STEPS IN APPLICATION

1. **TURN IN your child's application** to Casey OR have your JPS counselor turn in it by December 12.
2. **Keep email current.** Throughout the application process, we will communicate via email. If your email changes, please let us know.
3. **Attend Parent Orientation.** Bring along a copy of your child's January report card or pre-school report.  
**Choose one Session:**
  - Session 1: Tuesday, January 30; 8:00-9:00 a.m.
  - Session 2: Tuesday, January 30; 5:00 – 6:00 p.m.
  - Session 3: Thursday, February 1; 8:00-9:00 a.m.
  - Session 4: Thursday, February 1; 5:00 – 6:00 p.m.
4. **Sign up for Testing:** Children in Pre-K, Kindergarten, and scholars not currently enrolled in JPS: At parent orientation, you will sign up for a test slot in February.
  - Friday, February 9, 10:30-2:00
  - Friday, February 16, 10:30-2:00

If your child is already in a JPS school, grades 1-5, he/she will not need to test. Instead, we will get STAR Math and Reading from his/her school.
5. **Receive Response via USPS Mail.** On or before April 1, 2019.

### ARTS IN EDUCATION PROGRAM

1. All scholars participate in a music class and a visual arts class once a week. For 12 weeks each school year, scholars have either a dance class or a drama class.
2. Within the academic classrooms, teachers use visual arts, music, dance, and drama as tools for mastering math, reading, and content knowledge. Arts integration raises scholar motivation and builds skills and knowledge more deeply.
3. Arts and academic teachers work closely to reinforce each other's work and build a seamless web of arts integrated with academics.
