### **Specials**

**P.E.** – Monday 1:20-1:50 and Friday 9:00-9:30. Please make sure that your child wears appropriate shoes on these days ©. Our P.E. teacher is Mrs. Gordon.

**Music** – Tuesday 1:20-1:50 and Thursday 1:20-1:50. Our music teacher is Ms. Verburg.

**Library** – Thursday 1:50-2:20. Our librarian is Ms. Klenner. Please return books to school on Thursdays.

**Computer Lab** – Monday 12:00-12:30.

Counselor – Every other week on Thursday 2:20-2:50. Our counselor is Mrs. Rus.

**Art** – Wednesday 12:00-12:40. Our art teacher is Mr. Gibbons

#### Lunch

We will have lunch from 11:35-11:55 everyday. You may join your child for lunch any day, but please be sure to check-in in the office. If you plan to eat lunch, it is helpful if you can let the office know in the morning.

## **Supplies/Personal Belongings**

Please label all supplies and outerwear clearly with your child's name. Remember to label your child's personal belongings (backpacks, coats, hats, mittens, etc...) Please try to keep toys at home to avoid them being lost or broken.

# **Bookmobile**

The Siouxland Libraries Bookmobile will come to FAE. I will let you know when the dates are as soon as I know. Students who want to check out a book need to bring their library card from home. We will keep it at school and return it to you at the end of the year. If your child does not have a library card, you may send \$1.00 to school on the day of the bookmobile.

# Headphones

Students are required to bring their own headphones to school to use in the computer lab. These can be inexpensive earbuds or regular headphones. We will store these at school and they will be returned at the end of the year.

### Volunteering

I highly encourage your to volunteer at FAE. Your help means we can have a highly productive school year. With your help, children can receive important individual attention.
