



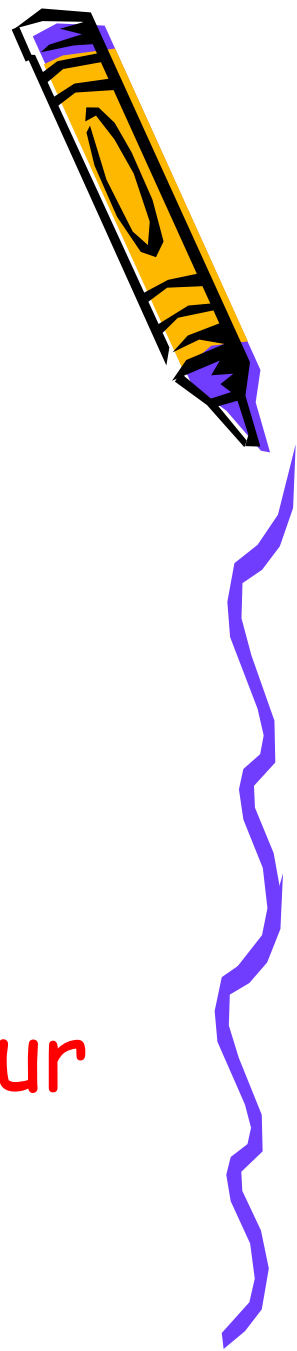

Vocabulary

- The Common Core Standards have a heavy emphasis on vocabulary. This year we will be using an online vocabulary program called "Spelling City." The students have access at home to this program to practice their words. (see sheet provided) There will be a lesson each week. A weekly vocabulary and spelling test will be given on Thursday. Each test will consist of spelling and knowing the meaning of ten words. A new list will be sent home on Fridays.

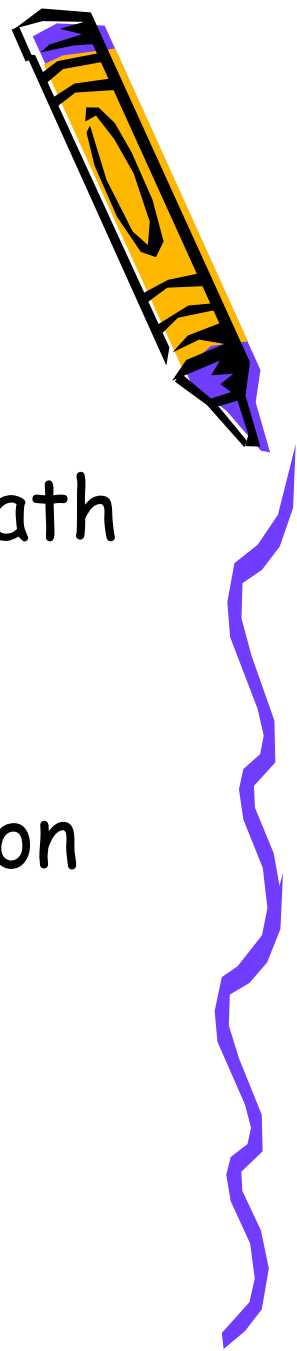


- The fourth grade Reading curriculum focuses on getting meaning from what you read.

- AR time is whenever we have spare time.
- *Accelerated Reading* - quarterly goal is 10pts in their reading level.
- AR points and their average comprehension percentage on AR tests will be put toward their reading grade.

- Hands-on discovery/Games/

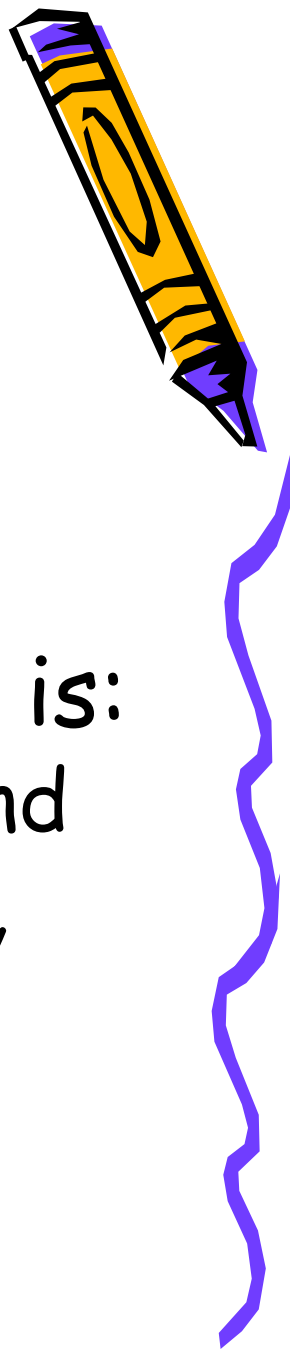

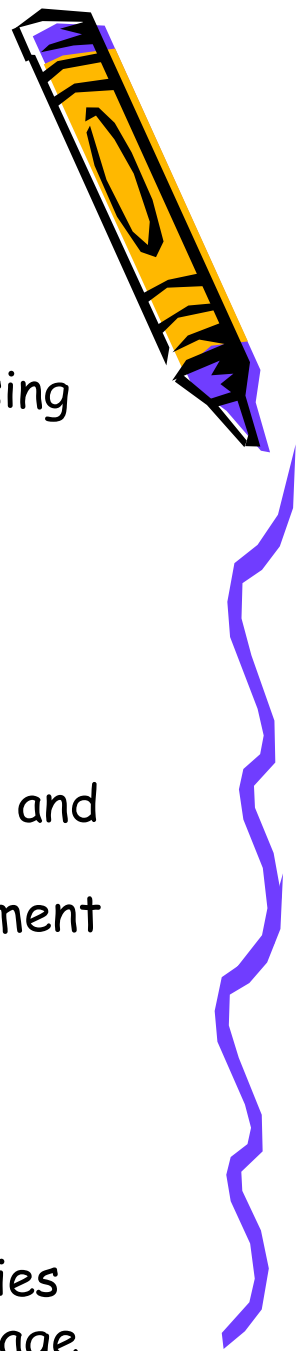
- Our focus is on the state of South Dakota - geography, history, people, resources, and the states and regions of the United States.
- Many different resources are used - textbooks, maps, the Internet, special speakers, hands on learning, home projects, individualized learning, and videos.



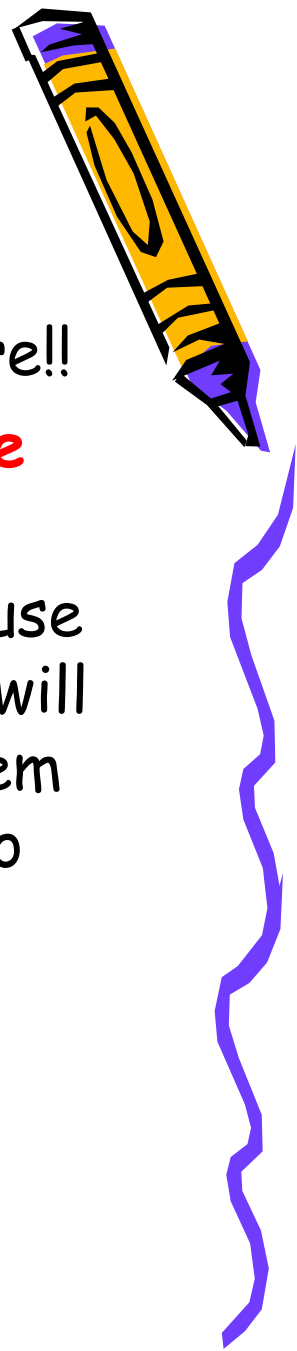
Technology

- Keyboarding
 - Learn basic keyboarding skills
 - Strive to reach a minimum of 12 words per minute using proper finger placement and technique
 - Check a document for correct spelling and grammar
 - Use cut, copy, and paste
 - Use toolbar icons
 - Use the Internet to search for information
 - Save to a storage device
 - Adjust the font of a document with alignment, style, and size
 - Use margins, line spacing, and justification in a document

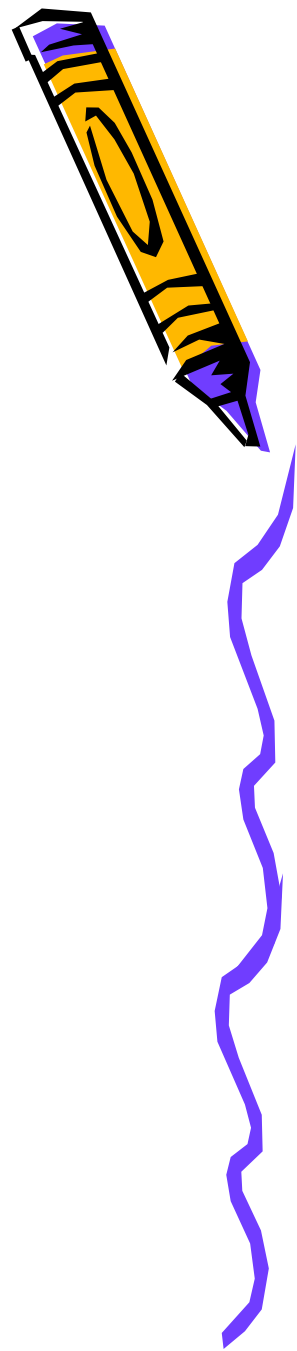
