Graduation Requirements

- A fine arts credit *is not* a graduation requirement. However, some colleges and universities do require one fine arts credit. South Carolina schools and many California schools have this admissions requirement. Be sure to check the minimum admissions requirements of each school you plan to apply to. This information can be found on each school's website.
- South Carolina schools (Clemson, USC, Coastal Carolina, etc.) require a **3rd lab** science. Biology, Chemistry, Marine Science, Anatomy and Physiology, Forensic Science, Physics, AP, IB and Career and College Promise sciences are considered lab sciences.
- Many schools also require/strongly recommend the 3rd level of a World Language. Again, be sure to check the minimum admissions requirements for each school.

Number of Applications

- College admissions have become increasingly competitive
- Apply to 3-5 schools
 - 1-2 Reach → academics are slightly lower than the admissions standards
 - 2-4 Match + academics match the admission standards
 - 1-2 Safe → academics exceed the admission standards

COLLEGE APPLICATIONS

- Make sure you send in all the required materials for a complete application
- Includes:
 - Application
 - Letters of Rec, Essays
 - Application Fee (or Fee Waiver)
 - Official SAT/ACT scores (if required)
 - Transcript



- MUST move college(s) to Applying To list in Scoir
- Choose correct application deadline! (Early Action vs. Regular Decision)
- Residency Number (if applicable)

SAT & ACT

- If you need to improve test scores, sign up immediately
- Free SAT practice tests available here: <u>https://satsuite.collegeboard.org/sat/practice-preparation/practice-tests</u>
- If you are going to a community college \rightarrow you <u>should NOT</u> take the SAT or ACT
- Most colleges will accept either SAT or ACT scores → no preference & weigh scores equally
- Many North Carolina schools are test optional for the upcoming school year
- <u>Fee Waivers are available for students on free or reduced lunch!</u> Stop by the Counseling Suite

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

- Ask *at least 2 weeks* before the recommendation is due
- Provide recommender with necessary information
 - Brag Sheet Survey
 - Found under "Me" and "Surveys" in SCOIR
 - Resume
- <u>Be specific</u> or they will write generic recommendations!
- <u>Be intentional</u> about who you ask

Residency Determination Service (RDS)

- North Carolina Residency 12 month resident
- Online application for all students applying to a NC college that are seeking:
 - In-state tuition
 - NC state grant for financial aid
- Not a resident don't try to claim residency!
- Public & Private colleges
- Students will be given a Residency Certification Number (RCN) to enter on applications



Financial Aid

• 2 Main Types of Financial Aid

- Need-Based Aid
- Merit-Based Aid
- 4 Ways Financial Aid is Given
 - Scholarships
 - Grants
 - Work-Study
 - Loans
- Must complete FAFSA to qualify for financial aid!
- Net Price Calculators

 - Opens in Dec. (date has not been released)
 - Based on 2022 tax forms

 - Set up Student & Parent FSA ID NOW



- Complete the CSS Financial Aid Profile
 - Opens Oct. 1
 - Only 5 NC Schools: Duke, Davidson, Wake Forest, UNC-CH, Elon

NC Promise

- Four schools in North Carolina participate in the NC
 Promise program which significantly reduces tuition to
 \$500 per semester.
 - Elizabeth City State University
 - Fayetteville State University
 - The University of North Carolina at Pembroke
 - Western Carolina University



Military Options

- Different military branches visit SVHS throughout the year
- <u>The ASVAB test is REQUIRED</u> (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery) for entrance into the military
- SVHS will offer the ASVAB test 9 times this year!
