2017-18 PARKING LOT RULES AND REGULATIONS**

DRIVING TO SCHOOL IS A PRIVILEGE, NOT A RIGHT!

1. All vehicles are to be properly registered in Mr. Roth's Office.
2. Permits are to be displayed on the lower left rear window daily.
 - No parking on any lot without displaying a corresponding numbered permit.
 - Permit, license numbers, and vehicle description must correspond.
 - Permits may not be transferred to another student.
 - Permits are sold on a first come first serve basis starting the morning of Registration. The price is \$25.00.
3. Vehicles are to be properly parked in designated parking spaces in the proper lots.
 - LOT A: Teachers reserved parking. Special privileged parking may be revoked for poor school citizenship or inappropriate behavior.
 - LOT B and C : Seniors
 - LOT D: All 10-12th graders that have registered vehicles and displayed permits.
4. Street parking in designated area is available on Westwind Dr. on a first come first serve basis. Students may park on the **school side** of Westwind Drive. Please respect our neighbors across the street on Westwind. *No Parking* signs are placed along Westwind by the City of Festus and will be enforced by the Festus Police Department.
5. Students are not to park in faculty parking at any time. Students are not to park on the maintenance building parking lot, Central Office, Intermediate, Elementary and Middle School parking lots, high school faculty lots, visitor parking high school lot A, student bus lot, secretary or substitute assigned parking spots, visitor parking , designated non-parking areas by Westwind/St. Mary's trailers and the hill up to the Intermediate.
6. Tickets will be issued to students for parking across the street from the school on Westwind Drive in designated no parking areas, by fire hydrants, on both sides of North Fifth St. from Westwind Dr. to Billy Porter Park, up the hill to the Intermediate school and in no parking areas by the trailers.
7. Temporary medical parking spaces are available upon administrative approval.
8. No loitering inside or outside of vehicles before or after school.
9. Students must exit off of the student lot, not the bus lot.
10. .No careless or reckless driving will be tolerated.
11. No student should be in the parking lot during school w/out a pass or permission to leave school.
12. Although it may seem harmless to drive up rock piles or through grass, this behavior is dangerous and destructive and will not be tolerated. Do not cut across the grassy area from Lot C to Lot D.
13. Squealing of tires or driving recklessly will be reported to authorities and will result in loss of driving privileges.

**ANY PROBLEM CONCERNING YOUR VEHICLE OR PERMIT
SHOULD BE REPORTED UPON ARRIVAL TO SCHOOL**

Consequence Guidelines

- 1st offense- Warning/ Possible suspension of privileges
- 2nd offense- Suspension of driving privilege for 1-2 weeks
- 3rd offense- Suspension of driving privilege for 1 month
- 4th offense- Loss of driving privilege

SEVERITY CLAUSE- In the event of any major incidents, poor student citizenship, poor attitude or cooperation, the administration may enforce to the fullest extent the maximum penalties. In the event of student discipline for parking/driving infractions, no refund on parking permits will be issued.
