All services are available 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. Duration of treatment varies from person to person but stabilization, referral, and linkage are achieved in every instance.	The PES/Screening Center offers immediate crisis intervention services, which are culturally competent, as well as service procurement to de-escalate client's distress and to help maintain or recover his/her level of functioning.
