PASS/PLAY POLICY

Final Draft

The following guidelines will be used to ensure that our activities participants are academically at their strongest to compete.

According to **Tiger Beliefs** (which all athletes are required to sign), "I will study hard, complete assignments, and make every effort to earn better than average academic grades."

This policy is designed to assist our student activities participants to accomplish the aforementioned belief.

- 1. All middle school student participants in Huron school districtsponsored activities (6-12th grade) must be passing ALL classes with a 60 percent or higher grade point average to be eligible to compete.
- 2. Matches, games, tournaments, meets, performances, competitions, intramural activities, etc. will fall under this policy. However, graded participation will not--i.e., band or vocal concerts that are directly related to the student's grade in the class.
- 3. Teachers will submit failing lists to the office each Thursday by 3:20 p.m.
- 4. The office will compile a list, by grade level, of the students and the classes they are not passing. This list will be distributed to all activity coaches and/or sponsors of activities by Friday at 3:20 p.m.
- 5. Academic ineligibility will take effect Sunday morning for those students on the list. Students will remain ineligible for the entire week until the following Sunday morning.
- 6. Ineligibility will mean students may not compete in <u>any</u> scheduled competition for that week, and the student must bring his/her grades up to a passing mark.
- 7. During ineligibility, the students will still attend practice.
- 8. A student will be reinstated to active status when his/her name does not appear on the failure list.
