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#### **HEALTH AND MEDICAL**

#### **NEW! Clinical Medical Assistant (140 Hours)**

The Clinical Medical Assisting program is designed to prepare students to function as professionals in multiple healthcare settings. Medical assistants with a clinical background perform various clinical tasks including assisting with minor procedures, performing an EKG electrocardiogram, obtaining laboratory specimens for testing, educating patients, administering medications and other related tasks. Job opportunities are prevalent with physician's offices, clinics, chiropractor's offices, hospitals and outpatient facilities. The purpose of this program is to prepare students to assist physicians by performing functions related to the clinical aspects of a medical office. High school diploma or GED required. Partnership with Condensed Curriculum International (CCI).

Exam fee: \$99.00 payment due before taking exam

Tuition: \$2,844.00

Payment Plan: Three payments of \$948.00



#### Medical Billing & Coding (80 Hours)

Medical billing and coding is one of the fastest growing careers in the healthcare industry today. The need for professionals who understand how to code healthcare services and procedures for third-party insurance reimbursements is growing substantially. Physician practices, hospitals, pharmacies, long-term care facilities, chiropractic practices, physical therapy practices, and other healthcare providers all depend on medical billing and coding for insurance carrier reimbursements. This program delivers the skills students need to solve insurance billing and coding problems. It details proper assignment of codes and the process to file claims for reimbursements. With the transition to ICD-10, effective as of October 1, 2015, this course will also provide training in ICD-10-CM. High school diploma or GED required.

#### **EKG Technician (50 Hours)**

The EKG technicians are in demand! EKG technicians work in physician's offices, hospitals, clinics, and other healthcare facilities and organizations. EKG technicians also work for insurance companies to provide data for health and life insurance policies. EKG technicians are expected to grow substantially. This EKG Technician program prepares students to function as EKG technicians. High school diploma or GED required. Partnership with Condensed Curriculum International (CCI).

#### **Phlebotomy Technician (90 Hours)**

The phlebotomist is a vital member of the clinical laboratory team, whose main function is to obtain patients' blood specimens by venipuncture and microcollection for testing purposes. Phlebotomists are employed throughout the healthcare system including hospitals, neighborhood health centers, medical group practices, HMO's, public health facilities, veteran hospitals, insurance carriers, and other healthcare settings. The Phlebotomy Technician Program prepares professionals to collect blood and other specimens from clients for the purpose of laboratory analysis. High school diploma or GED required. Partnership with Condensed Curriculum International (CCI).

#### **NEW!** Medical Administrative Assistant (50 Hours)

Medical administrative assistants primarily work in doctors' offices, clinics, outpatient settings, hospitals, and other healthcare settings. The Medical Administrative Assistant Program prepares students to function effectively in many of the administrative and clerical positions in the healthcare industry. It provides students a well-rounded introduction to medical administrative that delivers the skills students require to obtain an administrative medical assistant position or advance within their current healthcare career. High school diploma or GED required.

Practical Nursing Program (PN) Registration will open April 1, 2022

Applicants interested in the PN program must take the ATI TEAS entrance test. Test consists of four categories: Reading Comprehension, Grammar, Math and Vocabulary. A Study guide is available for purchase on the ATI website. The cost to take the TEAS test online/proctored is \$115. Classes start each September and continue through June. curriculum is 20 months long (Phase 1 and Phase 2) and runs concurrently from September-June for two years. Upon completion of the program graduates are eligible to take the NCLEX-PN for licensure by the State of Virginia. Students will incur other costs outside of the program cost. #### **NEW!** Patient Care Technician Program (120 Hours)

Patient Care Technicians must possess the technical skills necessary to service complex patient personal care issues including the implementation of selected portions of a specific care plan that may include rehabilitation services, basic bedside care, collection of laboratory specimens, Phlebotomy and EKG's. The Patient Care Technician works alongside doctors, nurses and other healthcare providers to oversee and monitor patients. This Patient Care Technician program will provide you with the basic medical knowledge and hands on skills necessary to perform or obtain technical diagnostic testing and perform direct patient care. The Patient Care Technician Program This comprehensive 120hour Patient Care Technician program is designed to prepare students for employment as advanced cross trained patient care technicians, patient care associate or nurse technicians under the supervision of licensed and registered nurses. Among other lecture topics, this program includes medical terminology: anatomy and physiology: patient care concepts in addition to labs requiring a student to practice and demonstrate EKG, Phlebotomy and base line nursing practical skills.
