Medical Arts Academy

The Medical Arts Academy program provides coursework and experiences that prepare students for early career exploration and preparation for all allied healthcare professions. Students participate in a capstone experience receiving an internship at Aspen Hills and Deborah Hospital. Students earn their A.M.C.A. certificate, a national certification recognized by the healthcare industry, to support future employment as a Nursing Assistant. Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID)

The AVID program's mission focuses on providing access to four-year colleges for students in the academic middle capable of completing a college preparatory path so that they achieve success in a rigorous curriculum.

Career and Technical Education (C.T.E.)

The Career and Technical Education programs offer various courses such as *Graphic Arts, Culinary/Commercial Baking, Health Occupations, Horticulture, Automotive Mechanics, and Nursing Assistant.* Work experience is also available via Cooperative Business Education, Cooperative Industrial Education, and Cooperative Marketing Education.

College Accelerated Program (C.A.P. Courses)

P.T.H.S. students can get a "jump-start" on their college careers by enrolling in over 30 C.A.P. courses. Through an agreement with Rowan College at Burlington County College, students can obtain both high school credit and college credit for select courses in a variety of subjects.

Honors and Advanced Placement Courses

P.T.H.S. offers over 15 Advanced Placement Courses and 30 Honors classes. Studies have shown that the rigor of a student's high school curriculum is the single best predictor of success in college. Most U.S. colleges and many international ones have an A.P. Credit Policy that allows students who have taken A.P. courses or exams to earn college credit, placement, or both.

Junior Reserve Officer's Training Corps (J.R.O.T.C.)

The high school J.R.O.T.C. is an exemplary unit, as noted by its designation as an Honor Unit with Distinction. Awarded by the United States Army Reserve Officers' Training Corps, this award is the highest unit level rating possible in Army J.R.O.T.C. The Pemberton Township High School J.R.O.T.C. is active in *community service*, school support, and has an award winning Drill Team, Color Guard, and Air Rifle Team.
