Quarter Events Assignment

Purpose

To get each student out of the classroom and to be able to properly find and cover events in the local community. This allows for the freedom of choosing what the student wants to photograph.

In the Industry

When you're working either freelance or for a company, be it Photojournalist or Event Photographer, you will sometimes need to cover events that you typically would not normally photograph. There are plenty of photographers who have become famous for taking photos at sporting events or events in the community.

What You Need to Photograph

The purpose of this ongoing assignment is to provide photos back to our community: Flowing Wells High School. To do so any and all events are to be connected to Flowing Wells School District.

Things that count: Sports games, Lover's Leap, Pep Assemblies, Classroom Activities(Science Labs, etc), Photo Club requests, Dances, and other things.

Things that will not count: Your Sister's Baby Shower, Your Bro's Sweet Skateboarding Skills, etc

This can be achieved during school hours, not just after school. When in doubt ask Mr. Nistas.

Photo Requirements

Students will be required to use the Life Photo Essay formula when taking photos of events. These are as follow:

- **Signature -** 10 Points
- Establishing/Overall 10 Points
- Portrait 10 Points

- Close Up 10 Points
- Interaction 30 Points
- The Clincher 10 Points

You will also need to turn in a contact sheet of 30 images(Varies depending on event, 20 Points). Contact sheet and all photos MUST be named correctly to be graded. All categories are at least one photo with *Interaction* needing at least three. Additional photos may be submitted for possible extra credit. All photos must be processed before turning them in.

When is the project due?

This project is ongoing and will be due after each month(You are able to photograph an event up until the last day of the month and then must have it turned in by the next school day). Check with Mr. Nistas on the required amount of events you'll need to cover. You are always

able to turn in events sooner rather than later. If the event is newsworthy(Sports, etc), you'll need to turn in the photos sooner rather than later.
