SHOOT A GREAT EXAMPLE OF EACH OF THESE. THE MORE CREATIVE YOUR SHOTS, THE HIGHER YOUR GRADE. DON'T TURN IN USUAL, BORING SHOTS! REMEMBER, THIS IS NOT A RACE!

NOTE: IF YOU WORK WITH A PARTNER, YOU MUST ALSO SHOOT THE "EXTRA" LIST. The most important aspect of this assignment is CREATIVITY. Shoot something other than "the usual!"

<u>Your required list of things to shoot...</u>

- 1. Find a wavy line and shoot it from a bird's eye view.
- 2. Photograph something yellow, close up.
- 3. Photograph a jagged line.
- 4. Find an interesting triangle and shoot a photo with a person near it.
- 5. Photograph something tall from a worm's eye view.
- 6. Photograph two overlapping circles.
- 7. Photograph something bumpy with the light coming from



above.

- 8. Photograph something orange, using an extreme angle.
- 9. Photograph an interesting reflection.
- 10. Take a photo that features red and green.
- 11. Photograph the intersection of at least 4 lines.
- 12. Photograph something blue and textured.
- 13. Photograph something smooth that's part of nature.
- 14. Photograph a repeating pattern.
- 15. Photograph a person in full sunlight, in an interesting pose.

EXTRA THINGS TO SHOOT (these are REQUIRED if you are working with a partner, count for extra points if you are working alone).

- 16. Photograph someone looking through a window.
- 17. Photograph a unique shadow.
- 18. Photograph something that makes a natural frame.
- 19. Photograph a series of parallel lines.
- 20. Photograph something or someone that shows spirit.
- 21. Photograph an unusual doorway.
- 22. Photograph clouds in a unique way.
