







Here I tried to contrast two forms of nature by letting through the glass to view the observed tree due to using a wide aperture, the glass almost appearing as transparent as glass. The scene, a green glow didn't add this photo (except for brightness), as I wanted to keep the natural colours.

In these two experiments I have explored the effects of tearing the image apart before placing it onto the gesso. I have explored this effect to emphasise on the trauma the girl is in through the bondage or social networking. In the left experiment it shows the girl physically being torn apart, as though she's taking out of reality.

In these two photos I have torn the image out of its former typical rectangular shape. The torn edges help make the image look rough and aged.

In the gesso print to the right I have continued to use with the brown colour making the image look aged and with the shiny aspect relating to new-age things such as technology.

In the print to the right the shelter has been absorbed into the brown paper border effectively making the image look rustic.

In the triptych below I have explored different effects of applying a variation of different tones onto the photos. There again scratched and the wires to make them stand out.

I have rippled around the edges of the three images below so your eye is able to follow effortlessly from one image into the next.

In the experiment above I have used a ruler and a craft knife to scratch through down this I intend to give the image more energy. This scratch makes relate to the trap she is trying to scratch her way out of being engulfed by wires.



Gesso Prints

Over these two pages I have experimented with applying gesso onto different media, then placing photographs that have been printed out on plain paper on top. I have then left the gesso prints to dry overnight once dry I used a sponge to rub off the paper to reveal the gesso print.



Above are the four originals that I then used to gesso print, with each photo being applied to different kinds of paper, different aesthetic qualities were made apparent.

In the gesso print below I have printed onto plain black paper. Generous amounts of gesso has been applied giving an unexpected result of being having many different textures!



Above I have printed onto card this absorbed the gesso well.




In the photograph to the left I have printed onto corrugated card. This worked particularly well retaining the card texture directly to the image of the girl in the box. It has been rippled to give a textured effect.

To create controls of thickness I have placed string underneath the gesso, then pulled it off once the gesso was dry to create more texture.

Also stitched into the photo to form a connection to the light source of the truth in the photo and the subtle hand being shown.

Different tones of brown have been applied to different areas. In the section below I have combined acrylic medium to have a shiny texture.

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

Yellow flower. Yellow flowers are nice, and they are not bad. However, it is not very clear at the point where it is.







Why do things decay?
The main factors involved are:
- Temperature - Amount of oxygen
- Amount of water - The presence of microorganisms.

To create the pear image I focused on student and teacher interaction and how students and teacher were created of water and light. I then placed the students and teacher in black space to create texture. I then placed the teacher and light source in black space. This made my image visually appealing because the teacher helped to dominate the foreground. The pears themselves are the main focus of the picture however composition of the picture sends mixed joint visual cues in the sense of the image what the meaning is.



APPLES - The two images below are both of the same apple yet in each of them the composition is very different. In the first I tried to emphasize the varying and elegant curves of the apple by keeping the picture in color and taking the photo on a dull, pale background. The shape is also a main focus in the image as the little white dot is more effective against areas of contrasting tones as the skin meets the flesh. The scene in the background varies slightly and this helps to create a balanced photo - one with both light and darks. To improve my work further could have photographed it as a whole apple or turned it on its side. I may even want to batter it or letting it broken even more to create a more dramatic effect.



so I also even want to better it further by squeezing it or letting it brown even more to create a more impressive image. I chose to print the second image in black and white because as oppose to the last photo the fruit has time at not colour so I decided to experiment with composition. I balanced the apple one between my two fingers which created balance in my photograph. All apples are unique shape so I also wanted to highlight the blemish, red, misshapen nature of it by exaggerating the tone portion I did this by making the lamp in certain areas and varying the distance from the lamp to the subject of the lamp each time.


