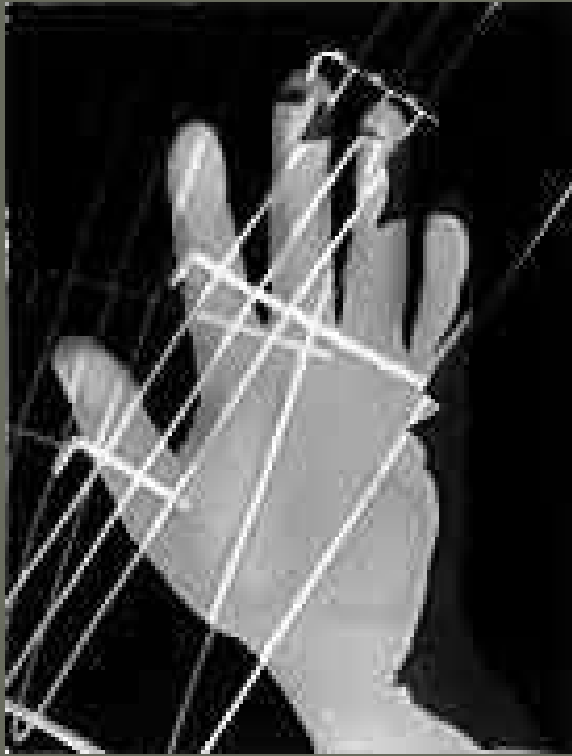

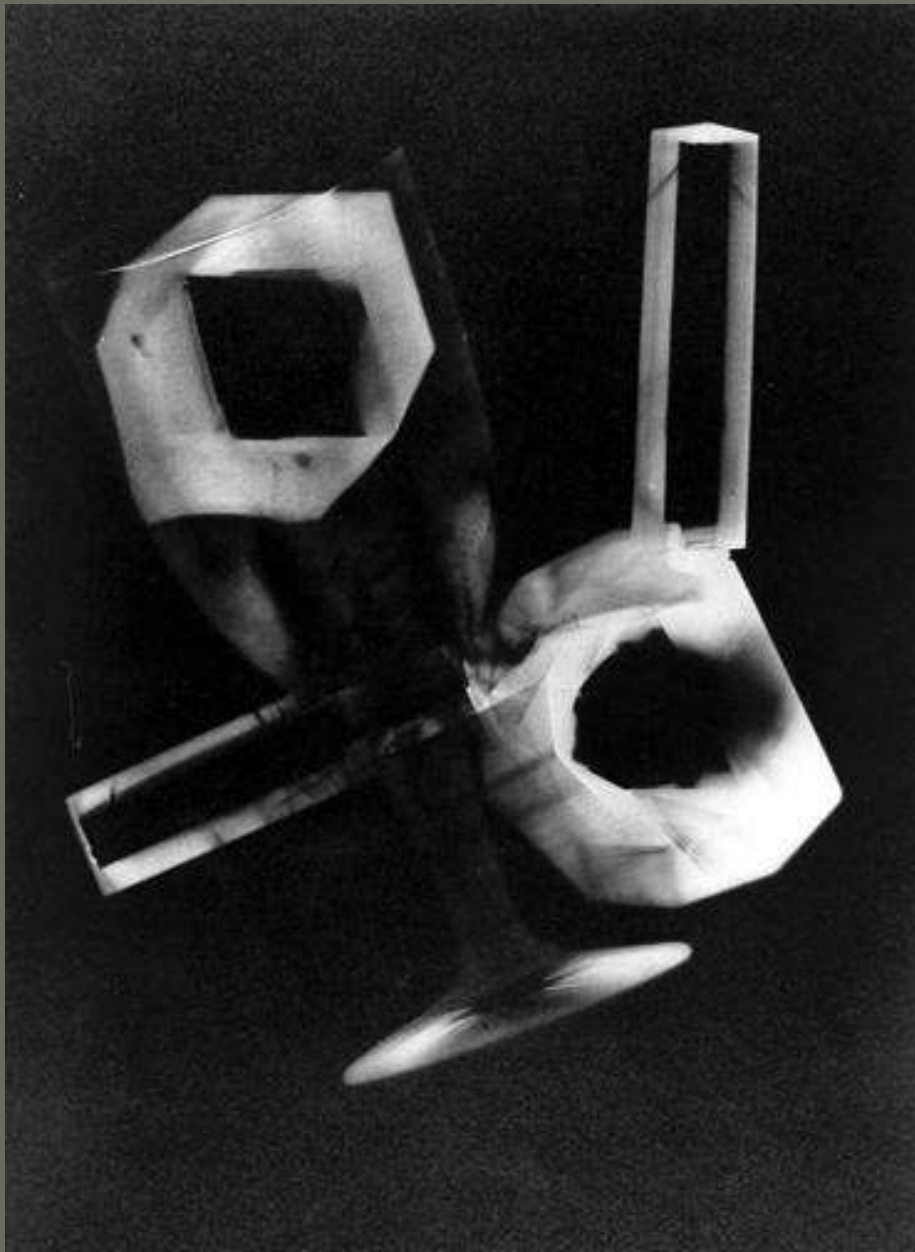


# What is a photogram?

(1890 – 1976)

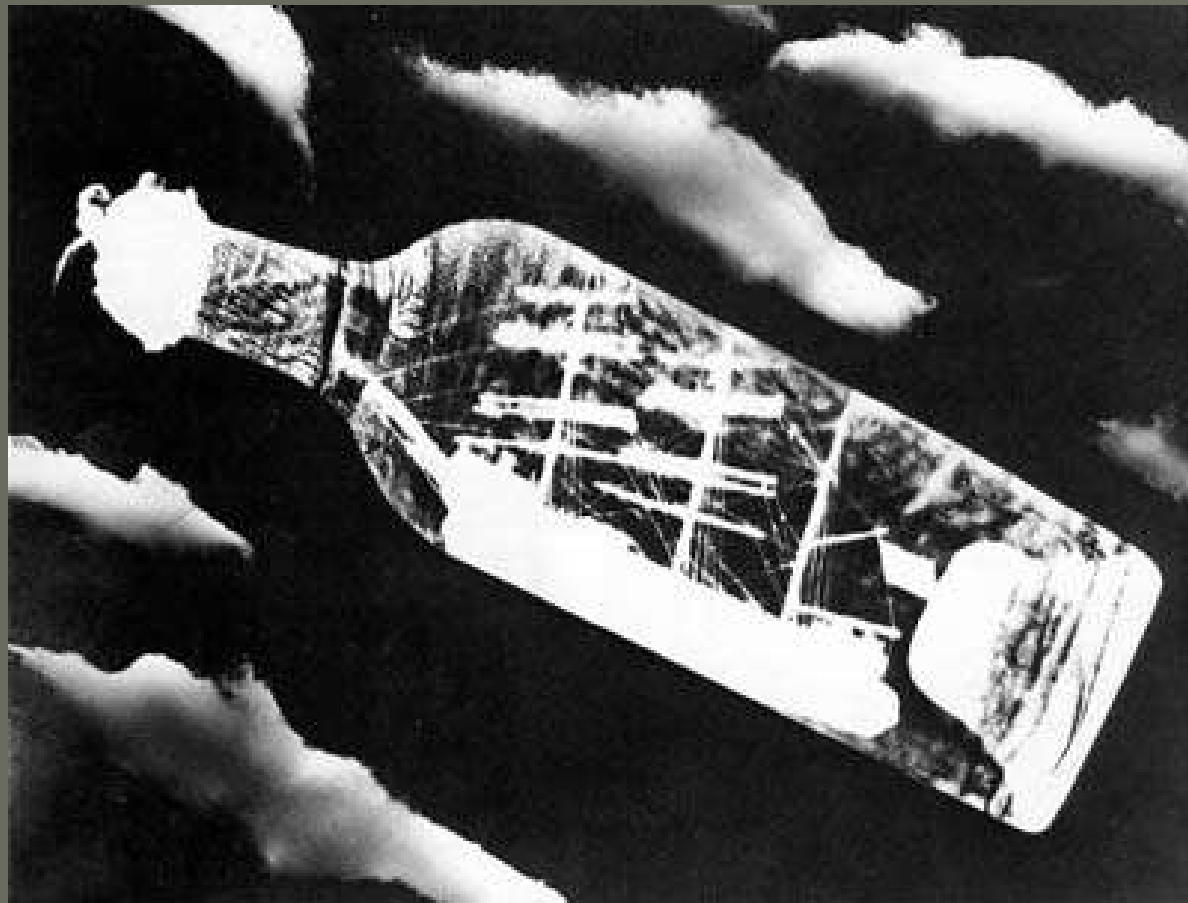
Man Ray was a

himself a

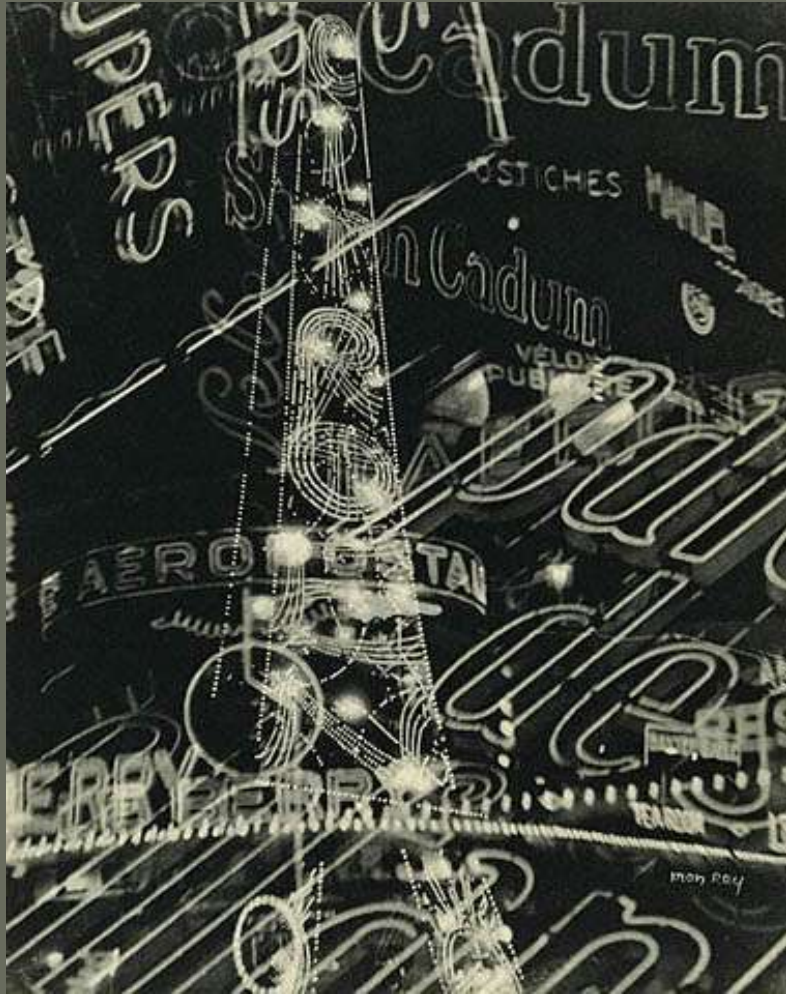
visual artist

Man Ray 1922-1924

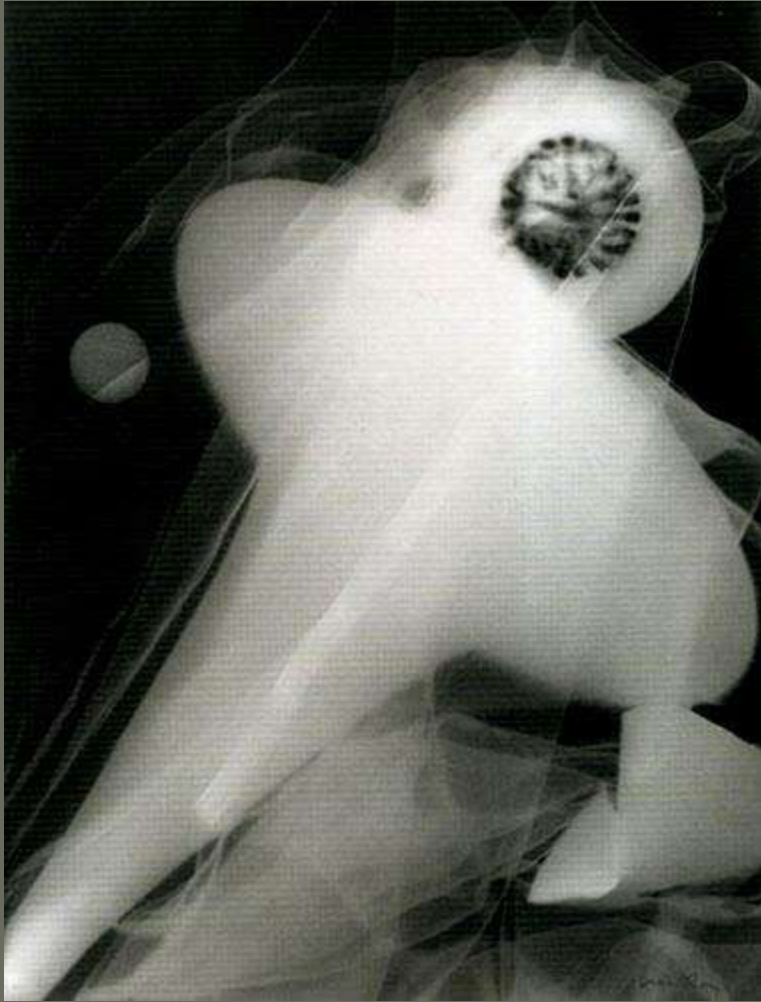
