


**Find an Action Shot where action is off to a side – these would all work (either save or copy the address)**



# Prepare the photo

- Open the photo in PhotoPea (File- Open or Open From URL)
- Use the Polygon tool to cut out the area that will “pop out” of the TV
  - If you mess up, just connect the ends and start over
- Outline the area you want to pop-out
  - Connect the ends to create the dotted line surrounding the area you choose





# Prepare the photo

# FIRST

- Create the “box” for the image in the TV
  - Use the Rectangle Select tool
  - *((SEE NEXT SLIDE IF YOU'RE NOT SURE!))*
- You may want to toggle the visibility of your layers



- Now, COPY/PASTE the selection (CTRL+C, CTRL+V)
- You should now have TWO layers




# Toggle to make a good “tv”





# Prepare TV

- Remove everything BUT the selected square that will go in the TV
  - Select – Inverse - DELETE
- Download the TV image [clicking here](#)
- File – OPEN AND PLACE (open the TV and put it on the working image)
- FREE TRANSFORM (CTRL+ALT+T) to move and resize the TV



# Add Shadow and Clean-Up

- Click on your CUT OUT layer
- Then go to “EFF” (layer style)
- Click on DROP SHADOW – You can play around with levels, or just click OK



# Clean up edges with the eraser



- ZOOM IN to help clean up (CTRL + +)
- Use the ERASER to remove excess edge
