## Assignment: Photorealism Self-Portrait Chuck Close

- 1. You will be creating a self-portrait based on the work of Chuck Close using number 2 pencil; Drawing should show influences from Photorealism.
- 2. Find a black and white photograph of yourself, or you may use a mirror. The picture should be a front or <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> view of your head and shoulders
- 3. You will **lightly** draw a contour line photorealism selfportrait drawing using a number two pencil; Head to shoulders required.
- 4. Study the proportions of the face; you may use a grid or freehand system for drawing proportions)
- 5. Practice sketching out the correct proportions on scratch paper before starting your portrait.
- 6. Practice using pencil to show depth and value on the practice portrait. Be sure to blend values showing the highlights and shadow areas.
- 7. Use white paper to sketch out your final portrait. Be accurate with proportions and details.
- 8. Begin using the pencil to show the wide range of values in the face. Accurately use pencil to show the highlights, shadows, and depth in the face.
- 9. Be sure to clean up all extraneous marks.
