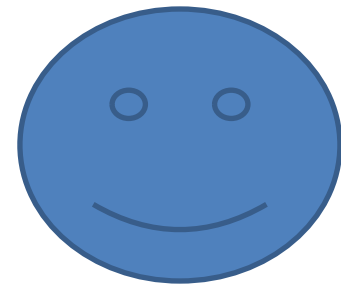

Physical Change

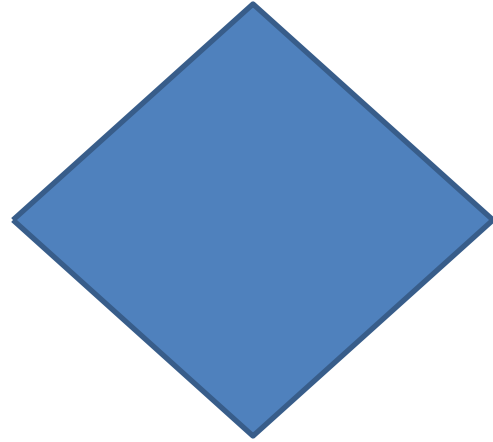
There are 3 kinds of physical changes:

- 2. A change in position or texture
- 3. A change in state

Change in size or shape:



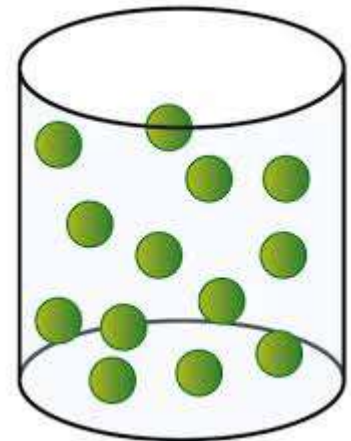
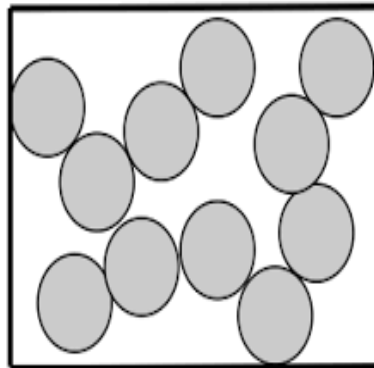
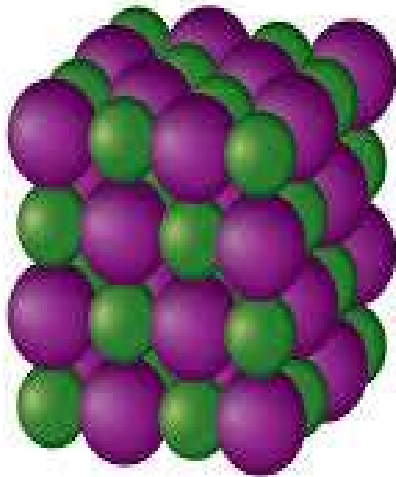
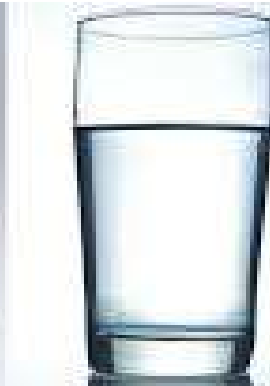
Change in position or texture



To change from a solid, to a liquid, to a gas, add heat.



Change of State



To change from a gas to a liquid, to a solid, take away heat.
