If you do not have a report of your child's exam at the time of registration, or your child has not yet had this examination, please check one of the following statements.

\_\_\_\_\_ I will have my child examined by a private physician at my expense and within 30 days of starting school and will submit a report of this examination by the physician to the school nurse.

\_\_\_\_\_ My child has received a physical within 365 days of entrance. I will submit a report of this examination within 30 days of my child starting school to the school nurse. I understand this applies only to the physical and not the record of immunizations.

**POSSIBLE SCREENING TEST FOR TUBERCULOSIS MAY BE REQUIRED FOR YOUR CHILD IF ATTENDING SCHOOL FOR THE FIRST TIME IN THE UNITED STATES OR TRANSFERRING INTO THE NEW JERSEY SCHOOL SYSTEM DIRECTLY FROM A COUNTRY THAT IS IDENTIFIED AS A LOW-INCIDENCE COUNTRY OF TUBERCULOSIS.** Please contact the nurse of the school that your child will be attending for verification whether or not this tuberculosis screening is required. This mandate is required by the rules of the State Board of Education and the New Jersey Department of Health (N.J. Regulation 6:29-4.2 and state law N.J.S.A. 18A:40-16.)
