<u>Math</u>

This week in **Math**, we will continue Module 7: Geometry and Measurement Word Problems. The skills covered this week are: identifying attributes of polygons, finding the perimeter of regular and irregular polygons, and solving word problems involving perimeter. We will have a **quiz Tuesday on identifying polygons and Thursday on finding the perimeter of regular polygons. The Module 7 Teacher-Made Assessment will be on Wednesday, April 20th. Our next multiplication fact quiz will be on Friday**. Please have your child study their facts each night and sign the green communication fact sheet located behind their Parent Involvement Guide in the maroon Lakewood folder. **We will have spiral review homework this week**.

Science/Social Studies

This week in **Science**, we will complete our study of space. **The space test is tomorrow, Tuesday, April 12th.** We will switch back to social studies on Wednesday to begin studying our government. Our focus will be on the 3 branches of government. There will be a **quiz on Tuesday, April 19th covering the 3 branches of government.** Students should study the review guide given to prepare for upcoming assessments.

<u>Reading</u>

This week in **Reading**, we will review asking and answering questions. A review packet will be coming home for homework. **The students will have another teacher-made summative reading test next week.** On Friday, we will be completing test prep activities. A vocabulary list was sent home today. **Vocabulary words will be tested on Friday**.

Language/Writing

This week in **Writing**, we will continue learning about writing biographies as we read biographical mentor texts. The students should have completed their interview sheet last week to prepare to write their own biography on an adult of their choice. The students will begin writing their own biography this week about the adult whom they interviewed. In Language, we will continue to review parts of speech, suffixes, and conjunctions. Spiral review homework for the week was sent home today. They students will have a language quiz on Friday. Spelling words were also sent home today. Spelling words will be tested on Thursday.
