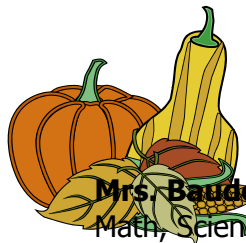

Math

This week in **Math**, we will complete Module 2 with the **district assessment on Tuesday**. On Wednesday, we will begin our work in Module 3: Multiplication and Division with Units of 0, 1, 6-9, and Multiples of 10. The skills covered in Topic A – Lessons 1-3 will be: studying commutatively to find known facts of 6, 7, 8, and 9, applying the distributive and commutative properties to relate multiplication facts $5 \times n + n$ to $6 \times n$ and $n \times 6$ where n is the size of the unit, and multiplying and dividing with familiar facts using a letter to represent the unknown. There will be a **Topic A – Lessons 1-3 quiz on Friday**. Please check over your child's homework nightly to ensure their understanding. Our next multiplication fact quiz will be on **Friday**. Please have your child study their facts each night and sign the green communication fact sheet located behind their Parent Involvement Guide in the maroon Lakewood folder.

Science

This week in **Science**, we will continue our study of forces in motion. Our focus this week will be on simple machines: levers, wedges, screws, wheels and axles, inclined planes, and pulleys. Students should review their study guide nightly. There will be a **quiz on Tuesday covering work, pushes and pulls, and friction**. On **Thursday, there will be a quiz on simple machines**. The **Forces in Motion test is scheduled for next Tuesday**.

Reading

This week in **Reading**, we will continue reading folktales and fables and discussing the characters, conflict, solution, moral and retelling events in the story. We will also compare stories. **The students will have a quiz on this on Tuesday and a teacher-made assessment on Thursday**. Students should also continue to complete the fluency folder each night and study vocabulary. **There will be a vocabulary quiz on Friday**.

Language/Writing

This week in **Writing**, we will conclude our unit study on Patricia Polacco. The students will be finishing their stories inspired by someone important in their lives or an important event that they have experienced. They will learn strategies for revising and editing their writings as well as learn about publishing their writings. **These will be turned in for a summative grade this week. The students will have a Language Test on plural nouns and prefixes tomorrow**. The students should also study their spelling words each night. **They will have a spelling test on Friday**.
