## ~ OUR SCHOOL ~

Pine Eagle Charter School is in a one-school district. Our average K-12 enrollment is 210. We operate on a 4-day school week with 145 student contact days per school year. Class sizes average 15-20 students.

Our school year begins with In-Service which is usually the 3rd week of August. First Day of School begins the 4th week of August. Regularly scheduled breaks include:

- Thanksgiving –week-long break beginning the Monday prior.
- Winter Break—17 days with classes resuming 1st week of January.
- Spring Break—week-long break 4th week of March.

In addition there are 8 Holidays during the school year, 5 with no school in session and 3 observed with school in session.

The last day of school usually falls the last week of May or 1st week of June.

## ~ OUR STAFF ~

Current Staff include 18 Teachers, 18 Support Staff, a .375 FTE School Nurse, a Technology Coordinator, Maintenance Supervisor, Superintendent, Principal, and Deputy Clerk. Administration utilizes a model where decisions are made with input from an Administrative Team.

The current Collective Bargaining Agreement allows for a beginning salary range of \$35,428 for a teacher with a Bachelors to \$65,421 for a teacher with a Masters and 18 years experience. Per the contract, all prior years experience is counted when being placed on the salary schedule.

Current benefits per the CBA includes an employer-paid insurance stipend of \$1,400 per month, cell phone stipend of \$25 per month, Tuition reimbursement of \$1,200 every 3 years, District-paid breakfast and lunch, District-paid preschool tuition, and District-paid contribution to the Oregon PERS Individual Account Plan (IAP) of 6%.

In addition to the scheduled breaks during the school year, the CBA allows for 2 personal days per school year.

## ~ OUR CAMPUS ~

The Pine Eagle School District Campus consists of 3 student buildings: The Primary Building housing grades PreK thru 3rd Grade, the Intermediate and High School Building housing 4th Grade thru 12th Grade, and the Vo-Ag Building for CTE, Shop, Building Trades and Ag.

## ~ OUR PROGRAMS ~

The District just purchased 11 acres of adjacent land for our Ag program to utilize as a Land Lab. The Building Trades program is planning on building a barn on the new acreage. In the recent past, the Building Trades Program successfully built and sold a residential home near the school.

Our Music program has become a strong and successful over the past 7 years and is supported by the District as well as our Community Partner, Pine Eagle Education Foundation (PEEF). We hold Winter & Spring concerts every year as well as a community talent show organized by PEEF.

Robotics Clubs for the lower grade and upper grades are additional opportunities for our kids to get involved in. The District is looking for more opportunities to provide a variety of club programs for our kids for afterschool activities.
