What happens next

- When you place a hold on a book, Ms. Wilson will get an email saying you want it.
- She will check it out to you and have it ready for you to pick up on Fridays from 12-2pm in front of the school.
- She will also have a cart full of books on Fridays, so if you don't place a hold on a book, you can still come by and check something out!

How to get your books

- Curbside check out is every Friday from 12-2 pm
- If that time doesn't work for you, books on hold can be picked up on Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons from 2:30-3:30 pm (Ms. Wilson will NOT be outside during these times, but she will be at the school).

- You can also tell your teacher what book you want and have them email Ms. Wilson.
