## Plan for Remote Learning in Grades K-12

Only students with a completed medical exemption application that excuses them from inperson learning will be provided the opportunity for remote learning. Forms must be obtained from the Office of Student Services at the Liverpool Central School District Office, completed by a licensed physician, and submitted back to the District. Once completed by a physician, the exemptions must be submitted to the student's school nurse, who will then submit the exemption to the District's physician for review.

Students in grades K-12 who are medically unable to attend in-person learning will be placed in an alternative learning environment. This environment will consist of instruction provided by one or more teachers that may not be directly associated with the school/district. Students in grades K-5 remote instruction can expect daily ELA/Reading, Math, and Social-Emotional Learning (SEL). Special Area Subject (SAS) lessons will be provided weekly for students to accomplish on their own or with the assistance of an adult in the child's home. Students in grades 6-12 remote instruction will be placed in the OCM BOCES Remote Learning Program.

Given the focus on returning as many students as possible to the classroom, Liverpool Central School District teachers <u>will not</u> be live-streaming lessons to students learning from home. Remote learning will be strictly limited to students who qualify with a medical condition. If physician-approved, each student will be enrolled in their respective learning program (Elementary and Middle School/High School).

If schools are closed by local, state, or officials due to a spread of disease or lack of available staffing resources, schools may have to shift to remote learning. Classroom teachers should be prepared to switch to remote learning quickly. If schools are closed for in-person learning, students will be expected to log in from home and follow their normal school schedule via video conferencing tools and online learning platforms provided by the district.
