What is Performance Learning Center High School?

Performance Learning Center High School is a non-traditional specialty school for students typically in grades 10, 11 and 12.* Students follow the NC Department of Instruction curriculum with the opportunity to earn college credit through the dual enrollment options as an Innovative Cooperative High School at Central Piedmont Community College. There is a strong emphasis on small class size, personalized learning, and community service opportunities. The varied class and service offerings allow students an opportunity to experience a well-rounded learning experience.

Who is a PLC High student?

A PLC High student is one who seeks a non-traditional approach to learning. A PL C High student is highly motivated to earn a high school diploma and has a desire to pursue post-high education options.

A typical PLC student has completed 1 full year of high school and earned the following academic credits:

- Algebra1 / Math1
- English 1
- Grade level/above grade level performance on state assessments

What is the process for admission?

- 1. Parent/guardian, student and home school counselor complete the Admission Referral form (found on the following pages).
- 2. Counselor faxes the completed Admission Referral form along with the documents listed below to PLC High @ 980-343-1117.
- 3. PLC High will contact parent/guardian and student to schedule an interview.

The following documents are needed to complete the application process and should be faxed to PLC High according to the instructions above. We cannot process incomplete applications.

- Admission Referral—pages 2-6
- Graduation Credits Checklist (obtained from home school counselor)
- Transcripts (obtained from home school counselor)
- Copy of 504 or IEP if applicable**
- Quick Look Up Screen from PowerSchool showing current schedule and grades

^{*} There are situations when 9th grade students may be considered for admission. Due to staff size restrictions, all parties should understand that many 9th grade courses will be provided through North Carolina Virtual Public School and facilitated by a PLC High staff member.
