- Art: 3 credits
- Health: 1.5 credits
- PE: 1.5 credits

- FACS: Interior Design I & II, Fashion Design
- Industrial Tech: Intro to Engineering Design I, II, III, IV, Architecture I & II, Cad I & II, Metals II & III, Woods II IV, Fab lab I & II
- Music: All courses

Community Colleges

- 2 year schools can provide two different types of preparation...
 - First option 1 and 2 year programs, precisely designed to prepare you for a specific occupation
 - Second option First 2 years of a 4 year program to transfer into a 4 year college/university.
- Entrance Requirement? High School Diploma
 - Normandale Community College
 - Inver Hills Community College

Technical Colleges

- Programs specifically designed to prepare you for specific occupations/career fields.
 - 6 months 2 years to complete.
- Entrance requirements? usually a high school diploma.
 - Hennepin Technical
 - Dakota County Technical
 - ITT Technical Institute
