Should I take the SAT/ACT? - If you are college bound, then YES!

When should I take the SAT/ACT? - March through June of 11th grade


How many times may I take an exam? - No limit, but we recommend twice for the chosen test.

SAT vs. ACT

Category	SAT	ACT
Testing Time	3 hours	2 hours and 55 minutes + 40 minute optional essay
Structure	3 tests	4 tests + optional essay
# of Questions	154	215
Score Range	Composite: 400-1600 SAT Essay; reported in 3 dimensions, each 2-8	Composite: 1-36 (writing domain scores 1-12)
Test Categories	Reading + Written Language, and Math	Reading, English, Math, Science
