

**AP Art History Favorites  
Poster Project  
Due 6-2  
100 Points**

Throughout the year, we have covered countless artistic movements, a plethora of artists, and closely analyzed certain specific works of art. Some of this content has endeared itself to each of you in a variety of ways.

For this assignment you and your partner(s) (no more than three people per group) are to pick 1 of the following:

**1. Favorite Artist**

- Name of the artist and his/her life span clearly placed on poster
- At least 2 noticeable images of the artist at different points of his/her life
- 5-7 clearly written/typed details about the life and work of the artist.
- At least 3 pictures of his/her famous works of art with a sentence explanation for each.

**2. Art Movement**

- Name of the movement and dates of its prominence;
- 2 known examples of art during this movement, with a brief typed paragraph explaining the work;
- An image of an artist/architect/sculptor from the period with a brief biographical paragraph; and
- 3 points that specify characteristics of the movement

**3. Work of Art**

- Name of the work of art and the year(s) in which it was believed to be made
- Images of any cartoons (preliminary sketches) or models (for sculpture) of the work of art
- At least 2 separate images of close-ups of specific parts of the work of art that are significant to interpreting the work
- 5-7 clearly written/typed details about the work including interpretations of the work, its current location, etc.

**Other Requirements:**

Poster board/paper at least 20" X 24"

Use of color and aesthetically pleasing arrangement of images and text

Nice quality images (not too fuzzy or pixilated)
