Overview of the needs assessment</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Principal shares results of the school needs assessment, what was learned from teacher SGG/PGP conferences and other data that was used to create focus for the goal. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>What did you learn from the needs assessment? What are your school's strengths? What are the areas of growth?</i> <i>What did you learn from your teachers as they shared their SGGs? How did that impact your choice of a goal?</i> <i>What did you determine as your focus for your goals?</i> <i>How do you think this goal focus is going to be beneficial for your students?</i>
<p>2. (it is ok if it is different but it would be good to know why.)</i> <i>Why do you think this goal will cause a change in teaching practice?</i> <i>Now that you have realized ____, what will you do about it?</i> <i>Describe how your goal will provide a “stretch” for you?</i> <i>How will this impact what you do in the future?</i> <i>What do you expect to be different in your classroom after you meet your goal?</i> <i>What evidence will you gather to determine your progress toward meeting your goal?</i> <p><i>Plan:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>Why do you think the activities you chose will produce results?</i> <i>Predict how your practices will change.</i> <i>How will you use the identified resources/materials?</i> <i>How will you collaborate with others? How will you share your learning?</i>
<p>5. Identify supports needed</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>Describe the types of assistance you will need to meet these goals?</i> <i>How will our conversation influence the completion of your professional growth plan?</i>

Things to consider as you meet with principals:

- What patterns are you seeing across the school in the identified goals/plans?*
- How can you group principals to support each other in this process?*
- What implications do the identified goals and plans have for the district as a whole?*
- How can you best utilize your resources to support principals? Support teachers? Support students?*
- What implications does the principal's goals' progress have on your own PGP and SGG?*
