Center Grove plans community forum on long-range planning for facilities

Greenwood, IN (May 5, 2015) – Center Grove Community School Corporation plans a community forum on May 11, 2015 at 7:00 p.m. in the Center Grove High School Performing Arts Center. This forum will include a look at the long-range facilities plan for Center Grove and give the community an opportunity to provide input on what building needs are yet to be met for our students.

Center Grove is in the midst of the \$42 million Safety, Security, and Stewardship project, which will address the safety and security issues for several schools, including secure entries. The project will also provide much needed renovation of classrooms in Center Grove Elementary, North Grove Elementary, and Center Grove High School. In January, Center Grove opened its new Technology Center and a new employee preschool and child care center, Bright Beginnings Early Learning Academy. The addition of Bright Beginnings completes the transformation of the former Maple Grove Elementary building into the Professional Resource Center. The next projects slated to begin this year include renovation of Pleasant Grove Elementary and the renovation of the former district maintenance building into a STEM Lab, which will be utilized by students in all grades K-12 and Center Grove's robotics clubs.

All of these projects have been planned and executed without increasing the tax rate for White River Township residents. This is a credit to long-range planning and vision by the administration and the Center Grove Board of the School Trustees. At the May 11th forum, administrators will provide information on future facilities plans such as when and where the next elementary school is needed and discuss future building needs in the corporation. All White River Township residents are welcome to attend.
