Grading

- Students will be graded on a point system that include the following weighted percentages of summative and formative assessments.
 - Summative Assessments (80%) include tests, quizzes, and projects
 - Formative Assessments (20%) include homework, classwork, entrance/exit tickets, guided math must-dos, and Study Island assignments

Quiz & Test Corrections

- Students have the opportunity to correct any quiz or test taken. Corrections will always be due the following school day that a quiz or test is returned. It is strongly suggested that students that fail any quiz or test take advantage of this.

Interactive Study Guide (ISG)

- Pre-Algebra students will all receive a consumable interactive study guide (ISG). Students will be responsible for taking notes and completing pages in the ISG in class. Students are also responsible for any notes they may have missed due to absence. At the end of each unit, students will turn in their ISG taken for a grade. All ISG pages and notes will be tracked on my website and Schoology.

Homework & Homework Policy

- Homework assignments will be on the homework board prior to each class period. Students will be responsible to record homework in his or her planner when he or she arrives in class. Homework will also be posted on my website and Schoology. Students are to complete homework and turn it in on time. In an event that a student has an emergency or does not understand homework, it is the responsibility of the student to contact me via email. ***(Expect to have math homework every night Mon. – Thurs.)***
