6th Grade Pre-Math 1 Clarity

Normally we identify students for our Pre-Math 1 classes using data from 5th Grade EOGs, MAP, Final Grades, and Teacher recommendations. However, the remote learning last spring did not allow for us to gather these data points. As a result, we determined that our current plan was not in the best interest of all of our strongest 6th grade math students. In the new plan, our strongest math students will no doubt rise to the surface during the first quarter of remote learning. At that point each of our 6th grade math teachers will begin providing them with enhanced learning opportunities as we move through the year. At the end of the year, we will offer Math 1 placement in 7th grade for those who have shown the ability to be successful moving forward on this accelerated track. It's simply not fair to identify Pre-Math 1 students now without any data, nor do we want to set students on a track that is not right for them. By the way, our Pre-Math 1 classes always show as Honors Math since this option was created in house.
