

# Preschool

We are growing!!! Literally!! In February of 2024, our Centerville-Abington Board of School Trustees voted to allow us to expand our preschool program for families wishing to send their children to Centerville Schools! Starting in **August of 2024** we will have **FOUR preschool classrooms** available to families. Here are some brief details of our new program:

- 4 classrooms offering an 8:30 - 11:00 AM session or a 12 - 2:30 PM session
- The cost is \$55 per week for 36 weeks
- Our program will follow the Centerville-Abington Community Schools Calendar
- Families who qualify for Free or Reduced price lunches may qualify for a Scholarship and may be able to attend our program for FREE
- Our program is open to any family wishing to send their child to Centerville Schools regardless of their residency
- Space is limited to keep class sizes small and will be filled on a “first come, first served” basis
- Your child must be at least 3 years of age by August 1, 2024 to attend
- Childcare **MAY** be available **if space allows** (see below for more details)

You will receive an informational letter no later than Friday, April 5, 2024 confirming your child’s AM or PM placement. Your letter will be inviting you to attend our **“Preschool Registration Night” on Tuesday, April 16, 2024** to pay the \$55 registration fee, receive your Power School enrollment information, provide birth certificates and shot records, and answer any questions that you might have.

We hope to provide childcare to families, but that will depend on capacity. Once all of our preschool spots are filled, if we have classroom space, we will offer a childcare option to families. This childcare offering would be available opposite of a child’s preschool session from 8 AM to 3 PM; for example, students who attend the AM session would be allowed to access a childcare room until 3 PM, or PM preschool students could arrive at 8 AM for childcare until their preschool session began at 12 PM.
