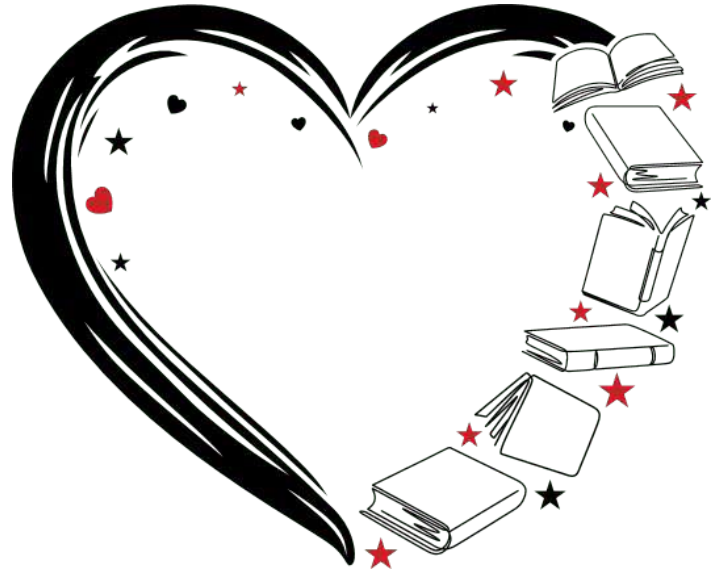


Cell phones are to be turned off and left in backpacks or lockers during the school hours (including lunches). If you need to call home, PLEASE come to the office. Thank you!

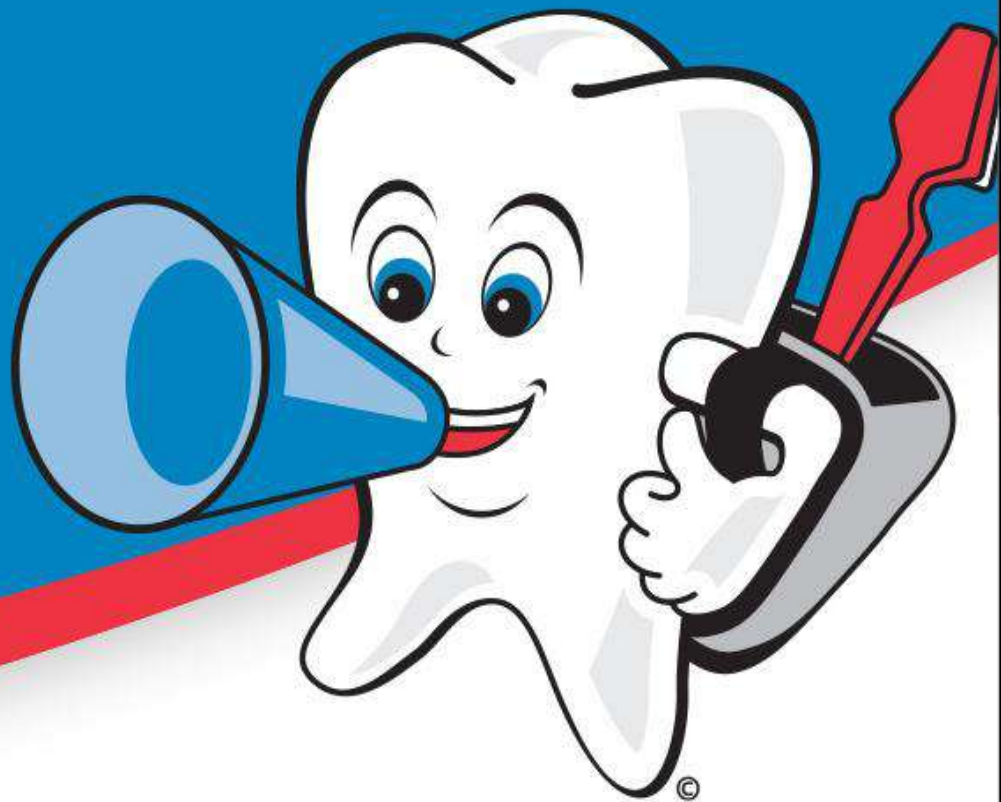
- Takes place from April 16 - May 24 @ Pigeon Creek

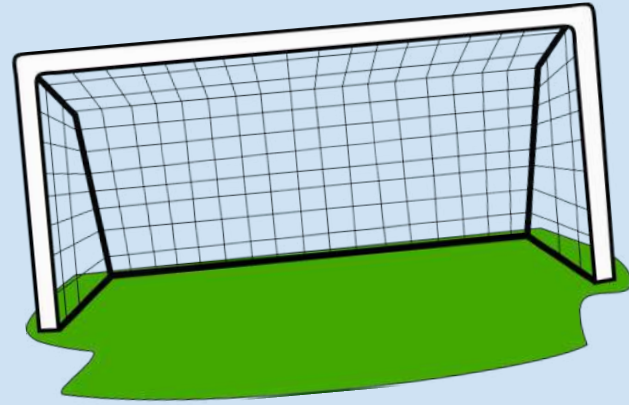
SMILE Program

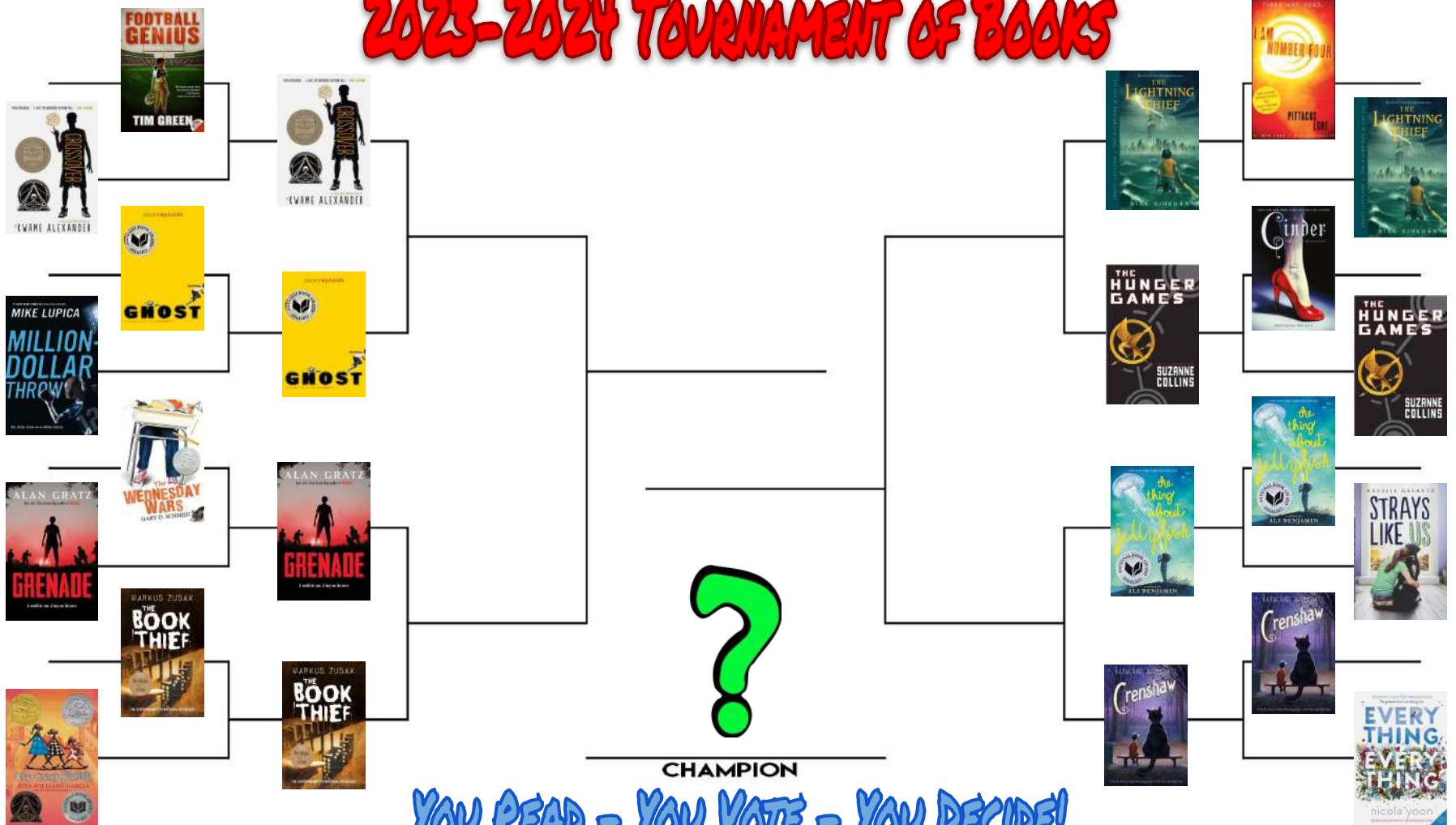


Girls Soccer

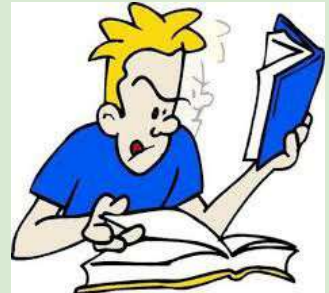
Do I have to sign up to attend? Yes - Sign ups on google form than can be found in the announcements. Sign up by 12:30 the day you plan to attend.
