### **One-Point Perspective Interior Room Checklist:**

- 1. Specific Location/Environment
- 2. Perspective is accurate and correct throughout the drawing: Focal Point, Scale, Detail, Light Source
- 3. There are at least **5 pieces of furniture**.
- 4. There are at least **5 household items/objects** besides furniture.
- 5. 3 household item/objects that are part of your personal story: Culture, Community, or Identity
- 7. There is at least 4 deep and 4 mindows
- 7. There is at least **1 door** and **1 window**.
- 8. There are at least **2 texture/patterns** (Principles of Art)

**1 item/objects** that is innovative/unique/creative.

- 9. Furniture is in **proportion** (Principles of Art) to the room and the other objects in the room.
- 10. Furniture has **appropriate details**, such as rounded-off couch cushions and edges of tables or shelves.
- 11. Space (Element of Art) is used well; there are not any big empty spaces where nothing is happening.
- 12. The Interior Room Drawing is shaded with a minimum of **5 values** (Element of Art) or colored with color pencil with a minimum of **5 colors** (Element of Art) with a clear light source to create shadows and highlights within your room
