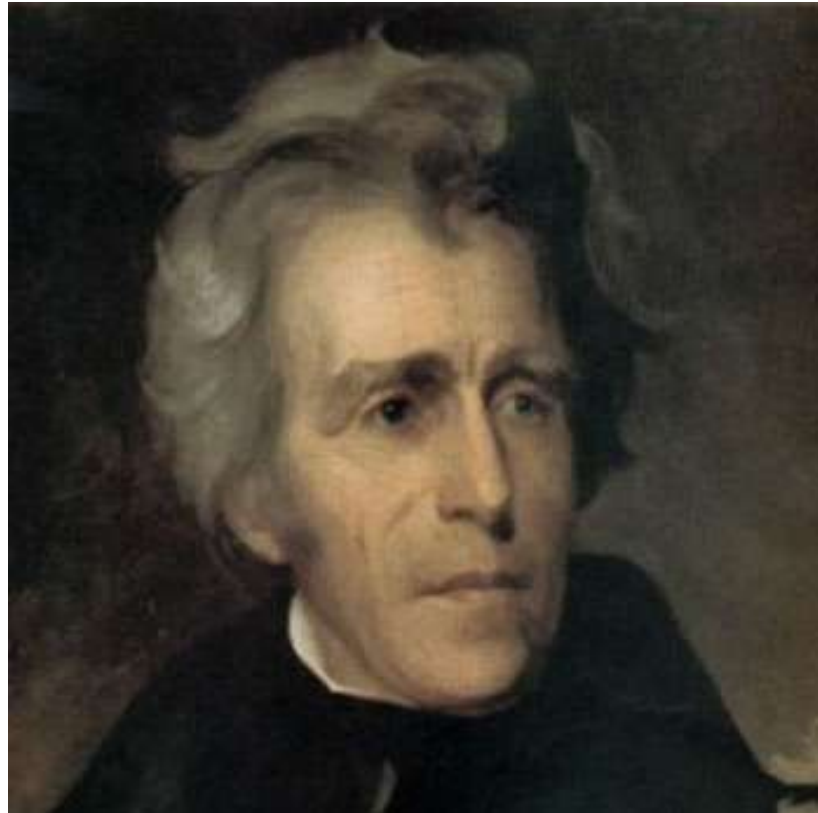


President Andrew Jackson (1829- 1837)

Introduced the **Spoils System**- Government **jobs** in **return** for Campaign **support**.

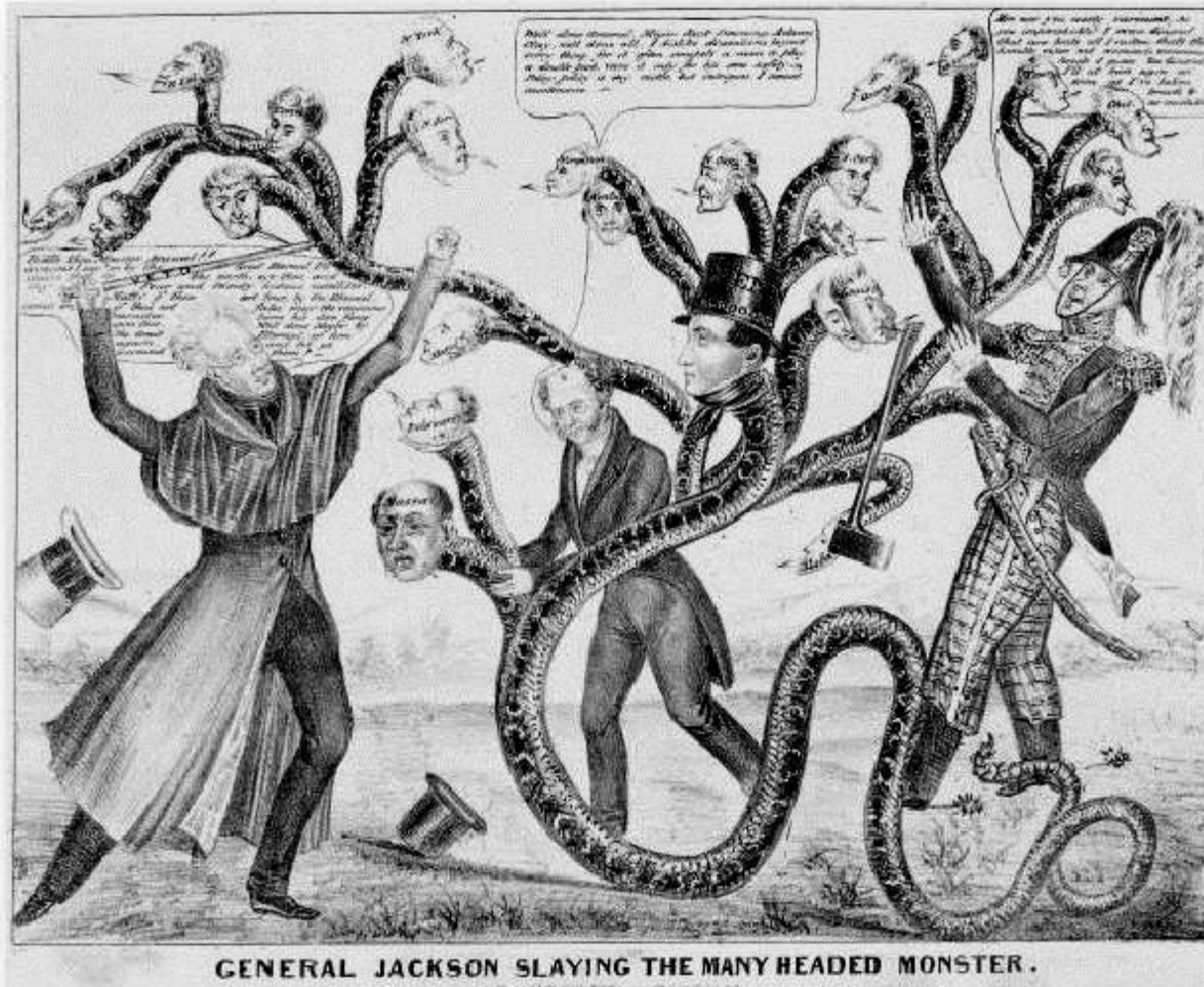
Quelling Sectionalism
