Nurse's Corner

- If a member of the household is being tested for Covid due to symptoms, your child must stay home until negative test results are in. We must have those results before your child can return to school.

OBJECTIVES FOR WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 13, 2021

Kindergarten Objectives

Math: 3D Shapes and Counting to 25

Science: What plants need

Social Studies: Identifying coins

Reading: Sight words (red, yellow, green, brown, blue), Classify and Categorize

Writing: Writing Strokes, Letters Aa, Bb, Cc, Ee, Ff

First Grade Objectives

Reading: Students will identify the plot of a story, and retell a story using strategies to understand the central message of a story. Students will know and identify the consonant sounds r, w, j, k, v, y, z, q (qu) and the vowel sound e and short u.

Writing: Students will write sentences with nouns, verbs, and adjectives using correct punctuation.

Math: Students will represent and solve problems involving additions and subtraction. Students will add and subtract within 20.

Second Grade Objectives

Spelling-Students will be able to correctly spell words with short vowels.

Writing-Students will be able to use capitalization, punctuation, and spelling patterns when writing a complete sentence.

Reading-Students will be able to fluently read a passage each day.

Math-Students will be able to identify and write addition number sentences using the part-part-whole strategy.

Spelling Words: rock, sack, list, tag, desk, chop, rib, job, mess, sad, dust, drum

Music/Art Objectives for the month of September

K: Students will learn to keep a steady beat a variety of ways

1: Students will review steady beat and the 4 types of voices

2: Students will review ta, ti-ti and shh rhythms

LIBRARY OBJECTIVES

KINDERGARTEN: The students will complete an activity we started last week using the Scholastic Magazine for kindergarten. The theme is "I Help Clean Up!"

We will talk about being tidy and messy and have fun with making a mess with shaving cream! The students will bring home the print magazines that the school has purchased for us!

FIRST GRADE: First graders will check out books and learn about taking care of library books. They will receive a color sheet regarding BOOK CARE RULES.
