Class Updates

We know families are eager to learn teacher assignments for this school year. Teacher assignments for students will be available in ParentVUE on Wednesday, Aug 30th, at 4:00 PM. School Supplies

As we have done for the past two years, parents will not need to buy or pay for regular school supplies. We will provide what is needed. Nutritional Services

There will once again be free, reduced, and paid status for meals. Paid students will need to start paying for meals on the first day of school. You can load your child's lunch account at BLPay on/or after September 3rd (the Sunday before school starts). All students who are registered for school on ParentVue at that time will be uploaded to BLPay with their school assigned as of that date. There are no fees for using BLPay.

This school year breakfast will cost \$2.50 and lunch will be \$3.50.

First Day of School

The first day of school is Wednesday, September 6th for 1st-5th graders. Kindergarten families will receive a separate mailing explaining the "staggered start" scheduled for Wednesday and Thursday of the first week of school.

School Hours

Gates and the cafeteria will again open at 7:30 AM, our first bell will be at 7:40 AM this year so students will have 10 min to play on the playground, and classes begin at 7:45 AM. Any student arriving after 7:45 AM will need to access the front of the school to enter. School will dismiss at 2:15 PM, except for School Improvement Wednesdays (12:45 PM). The first day of school (Sept 6), and the last Wednesday of the school year (June 12th) are the only full Wednesdays on the school calendar. School Improvement Wednesdays provide incredibly valuable professional development time for teachers throughout the school year around Storyline design and implementation, our new reading curriculum adoption, and a variety of other trainings.

Visiting or Volunteering on Campus

Please remember **all** adults must check in through the office before entering the school building. All volunteers need to re-apply every 2 years, so if you applied last year you don't need to apply again this year. Just a reminder, in order to help with field trips, help teachers in the classroom, or supervising/supporting any students, you must be on the approved volunteer list.
