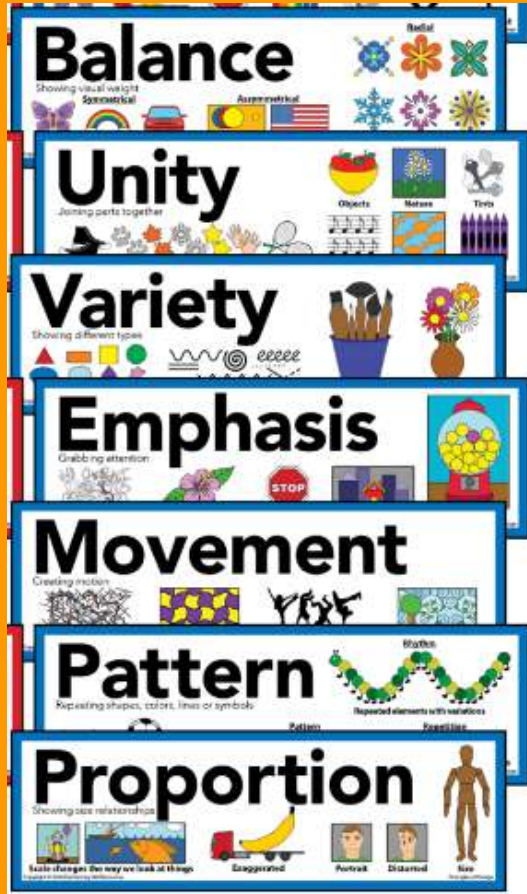

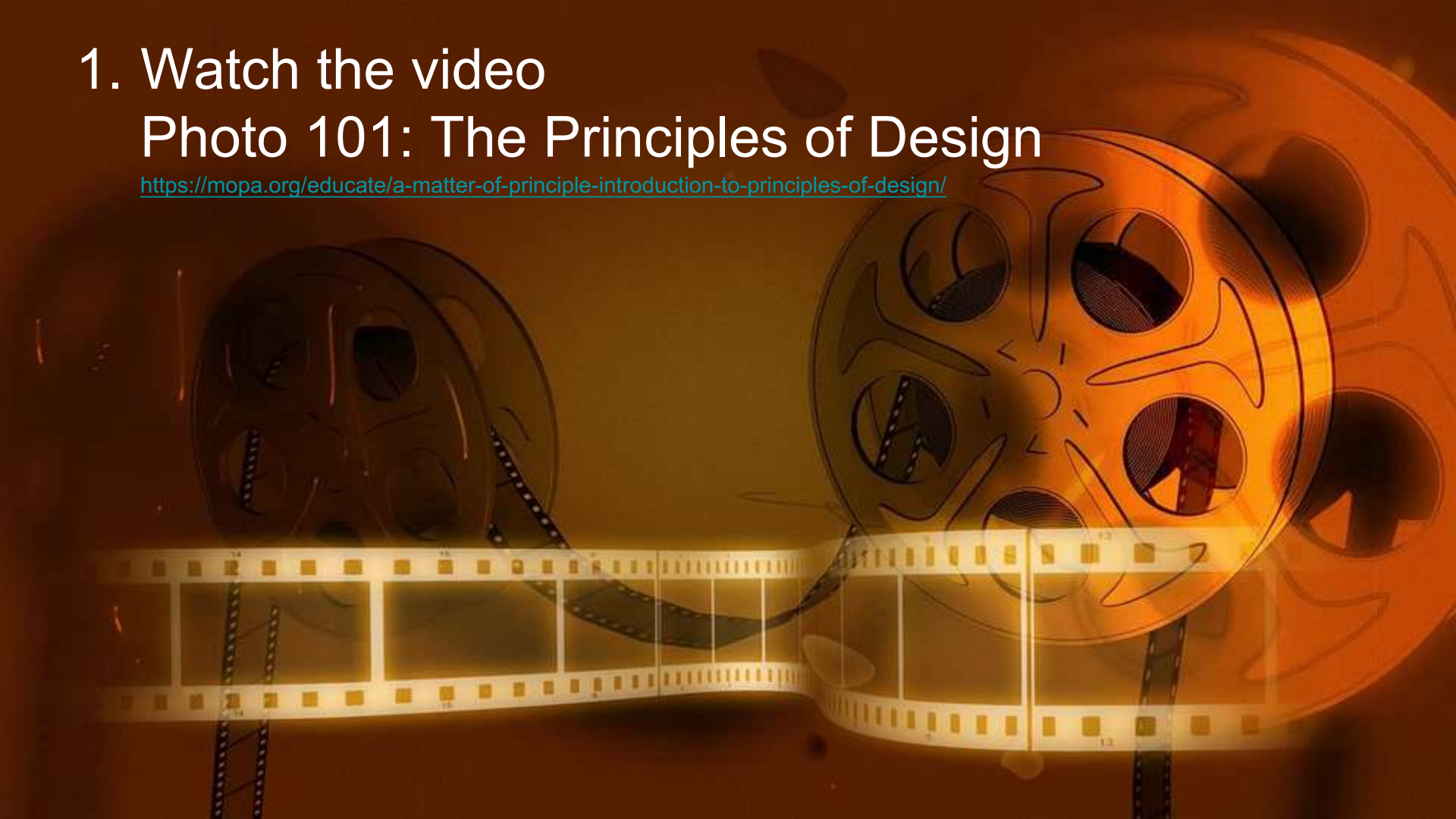


The Principles of Design are how the artist organizes the Elements of Art to create a complex and meaningful work of art.
