- **Adult Social Co-Chair:** works with co-chair (and additional volunteers) to plan and execute the Adult Social fundraiser in the Spring
- **Cultural Arts:** works with the school to bring in fun, educational assemblies and speakers to the school
- **Student Banking (TD Bank) Co-Chair:** works with co-chair to handle deposits during Student Banking (once a month during lunch) and brainstorms ideas to increase student involvement in this activity
