Instructions on how to register for the PSAT at High School East

WHAT IS THE PSAT/NMSQT?

The “Redesigned” PSAT/NMSQT is an exam that includes evidence-based Reading, Writing, Language and Math skills. The duration of the exam is 2 hours, 45 minutes.** The exam tests your ability to reason with facts rather than to recall and recite them.

WHY TAKE THE PSAT/NMSQT?

- Your scores will be helpful to you in discussing your educational plans and choice of colleges with your counselor and parents.
- The test is a shortened version of the “Redesigned” SAT, which will debut in March, 2016. The SAT is often required as part of the college admissions process. It is a good practice test, and only you and your counselor see the results.
- The exam provides Juniors with an opportunity to enter scholarship competitions administered by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation and participate in the Student Search Service of the College Board.
- Test results will be available to students via the College Board website, along with individualized tips on how to improve skills in anticipation of taking the real SAT.

Attention Sophomores: Your PSAT scores will be flagged* as ineligible for scholarship consideration; National Merit Scholarship/Award opportunities are only available to Juniors.

The use of cell phones, PDA'S, MP3 and electronic devices are strictly prohibited in the PSAT testing area!

***If you have been approved by the College Board to receive testing modifications/accommodations that include “Extended Time,” you must be prepared to stay longer than the standard time of the PSAT. Also, be aware that you **MUST USE** the accommodations granted by the College Board. (You cannot “finish early” if you receive extended time.)*


