## Instructions on how to register for the PSAT at High School East

#### WHAT IS THE PSAT/NMSQT?

The "Redesigned" PSAT/NMSQT is an exam that includes evidence-based Reading, Writing, Language and Math skills. The duration of the exam is 2 hours, 45 minutes.\*\* The exam tests your ability to reason with facts rather than to recall and recite them.

#### WHY TAKE THE PSAT/NMSQT?

- Your scores will be helpful to you in discussing your educational plans and choice of colleges with your counselor and parents.
- The test is a shortened version of the "Redesigned" SAT, which will debut in March, 2016. The SAT is often required as part of the college admissions process. It is a good practice test, and only you and your counselor see the results.
- The exam provides <u>Juniors</u> with an opportunity to enter scholarship competitions administered by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation and participate in the Student Search Service of the College Board.
- Test results will be available to students via the College Board website, along with individualized tips on how to improve skills in anticipation of taking the real SAT.

Attention Sophomores: Your PSAT scores will be flagged\* as ineligible for scholarship consideration; National Merit Scholarship/Award opportunities are only available to Juniors.


