PSAT REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR 10th & 11th GRADE STUDENTS

The **PSAT** (Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) will be administered at Cold Spring Harbor High School on **Saturday**, **October 17**, **2020**. **Test takers must report to the PAC no later than 7:30 a.m. with their calculators and two #2 pencils. We cannot provide calculators for those who forget them; if need be, the math test questions are able to be computed without a calculator. All students are permitted snacks and drinks during the brief test breaks; students who are qualified to receive extended time should bring extras.**

- The PSAT is a risk-free examination; scores are not released to colleges. You can visit https://collegereadiness.collegeboard.org/psat-nmsqt-psat-10 to learn more.
- Our counselors recommend that **all juniors** take the PSAT. Sophomores should consult with their counselor if they are interested in registering. **Only scores earned by juniors will be entered into the National Merit Scholarship Program.**
- Students must register and pay a \$35.00 fee to take the PSAT.

 The student's email address must the used for the registration.
- The deadline for PSAT registration is Friday, September 25, 2020 after which a wait list will be established. Proctors must be secured and trained, rooms and custodial tasks assigned, security matters arranged, and students with disabilities assured of receiving their pre-approved accommodations. These time-consuming tasks must be completed well in advance of the test.
- Test takers will receive their scores and score reports in mid-December online via your College Board account. If you do not have a College Board account, you are encouraged to create one prior to taking the PSAT. Create your account by visiting: https://www.collegeboard.org/

College Standardized Testing Calendar 2020 - 2021

SAT Subject Tests are best taken in June at the very end of coursework. Register for any June 2021 tests by March 1 as June test centers fill up early.

Students with Disabilities who receive any accommodations beyond time and a half should register at least 12 weeks in advance of the desired test date. Allow 14 weeks if you wish to test in June.
