## Transfer Equivalency Coursework Guide

All students earning a diploma from Hayfield High School must complete the graduation requirements set forth by the Hayfield School Board. For PSEO students, it is assumed that all courses required in grades 9 and 10 have been successfully completed. Beginning in the 2015-2016 school year, passing credit in the following courses at the PSEO institution will satisfy required high school coursework for enrolled students as Juniors and Seniors at Hayfield High School. If a particular course cannot be scheduled and/or is not offered at the college, it is the student's responsibility to ensure they are scheduled for the high school level course at Hayfield High School.

Courses taken at a college/university other than RCTC and/or RCC must be discussed with a school counselor and/or school principal prior to enrollment to ensure equivalency. These courses will be decided on a case by case basis.

Although the transfer credits from a PSEO institution to Hayfield High School is at a ratio of 4 to 1, additional courses and/or credits may be required to fulfill the content set forth by the MN Academic Standards and/or locally adopted curriculum.
